PBIS

PBIS stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports. All W-E Schools have devised a PBIS system in their schools to assist students with understanding what is expected of them as members of the school community. Using collected data on student behavior, the School of Innovation has recognized specific areas where improvement is needed. Specifically we are monitoring the following with the intent to improve:

RESPECT: Listening to others when they are talking
Walking during arrival and dismissal

RESPONSIBLE: Cleaning up workspace after lesson
Following check-in and check-out routines

READY TO LEARN: Having needed materials when arriving to class

Over the next quarter we will use dojo to monitor these areas and compare the data to the 1st quarter to measure improvement. Ask your student about these new goals!
