A general discussion took place among the Board members regarding their decision and vote for the emergency levy.

Mr. Parkinson quoted Mr. Manoloff, legal counsel, "the Board will not need to vote down the resolution that is NOT selected. It will die a natural death for lack of a motion/second. The minutes of the meeting will reflect the fact that it was on the agenda and discussed (along with the resolution that IS selected), but was not put forward for a vote."

No motion was made for item 1E, "A resolution declaring it necessary to levy an additional tax for the purpose of current expenses and requesting the lake county auditor to certify the total current tax valuation of the school district and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that additional levy, pursuant to sections 5705.03 and 5705.21 of the revised code".
