One School One Book is a unique program in which children at all grade levels will be reading and listening to the same book. This program builds a community of readers through a shared reading experience at home, and it's supported by exciting activities at school. It is like a great big book club! Reading professionals recommend reading material that is beyond your child's reading level out loud to them. Reading chapter books out loud with your children, even when they are able to read it by themselves, is also beneficial. Throughout the week, students have been given clues to help them guess the title of the book. The book we have chosen will be revealed at a kick-off assembly Monday morning. Your children should surely come home excited to begin this program! We have selected a title that can be followed, understood and enjoyed by younger students, yet at the same time will still captivate and interest our older readers. Following Monday's assembly, the oldest child from each family will receive their family's book, which includes the calendar of nightly readings and our OSOB website in the front cover of the book. Students will be engaged in daily trivia and various activities which will further enrich the reading experience.
