STREP THROAT ALERT!

There continue to be a number of strep throat illnesses at Grant. If your child is ill, please observe him or her for the following symptoms: Sore throat, pain when swallowing, enlarged glands in the neck, fever, stomach ache, headache or rash. If your child has a sore throat with any of these symptoms, we urge you to keep your child home and to contact your doctor for advice.

Should your child develop strep throat, he/she should remain home for at least 24 hours after the start of antibiotic. Your child must also be fever free without the use of Tylenol, Advil, etc., for at least 24 hours prior to returning to school.

Please notify the school any time your child has received a positive strep culture.
