GENERAL INFORMATION

Ice Skating Lessons are offered to all ages 3 and up. Lessons are geared to help ages and interest, including recreational skater, hockey, and figure skating.

- ◆ Children ages 3 to 5 start with the Tot program (Skill progression Tot 1,2,3)
- ◆ Children ages 6 and up start with the Basic program thru Freestyle (Basic 1-8) Freestyle (1-6)
- ◆ Teens & Adults ages 12 and up start with the Adult Basic Program (Beginner and up)
- ◆ New Skaters begin with Tot 1 or Basic 1
- ◆ Classes are taught in the Studio Rink unless otherwise noted
- ◆ All patrons registered in the Learn to Skate program will receive a punch card for open skate sessions good during the 7 weeks of lessons
- ◆ Skate Rental: \$1 Helmets are provided for 10 & under at no cost (bike helmet is acceptable)

Toddler Crawl: Age 14 - 28 Months

Does your Toddler beg to get on the ice while watching their older siblings? Now is their chance! Toddler must wear a helmet (provided), snow pants, gloves, and boots. Participants can walk, crawl, and play on the ice. Cookie and juice box provided.

Baby Blades: Age 1 - 3

This class is a fun, interactive and a unique way for a child to learn to skate. Learning to walk on skates before even entering the ice. Off ice games to help them become confident in their skates. Class registration includes admission to Playdate On Ice.

Tot Hockey: Age 3 - 5

Boys and Girls Learn skating skills such as balance, forward and backward skating, stopping, and turning while using a hockey stick.

Pre-requisite: Must have passed Tot 1 in the LTS Program

Equipment Required: Approved ice hockey helmet with full face shield, hockey gloves, hockey skates, and hockey stick (Straight Blade)

Instructional Hockey: Age 6 & up

Instructional Hockey is for beginner Boys and Girls looking to develop stick handling and hockey skating skills, ideal for players considering Playmakers hockey in the future.

Pre-Requisite: Students must pass either Tot 3 or Tot Hockey 4 to participate (if a 4 year old has passed Tot 3 or Tot Hockey 4, he/she may participate in instructional hockey). Students age 6 and up must pass Basic 1

Equipment Required: Approved ice hockey helmet with full face shield, hockey gloves, hockey skates, and ice hockey stick (Straight Blade). It is recommended that players also wear protective equipment. (Note: This protective equipment can be of any type, i.e. soccer or rollerblading etc)

Special Skaters Program: All Ages

This program provides an exciting and beneficial form of recreation for persons with disabilities. The program is available to youth and adults and instruction is included. Volunteers are on the ice to provide additional assistance. Through this program, students will have the opportunity to compete in Special Olympic events. Classes are 45 minutes each week.

Competition Class: All Ages

Skaters prepare for competition in a fun and exciting class. Learn a program to music and get ready to compete in this seasons Basic Skills Competition. This class is for skaters of all levels.

Pre-requisite: Must have passed Tot 1 in the LTS Program

Adult Instructional Hockey: Age 18 & up

Adult Instructional Hockey is for any adult who is looking to develop hockey skating skills, and the rules of the game.

Equipment Required: Approved ice hockey helmet with full face shield, hockey gloves, hockey skates, and ice hockey stick. It is recommended that players also wear protective equipment. (Note:
