Brian's Update

- Fox8 was at SOI today. Everyone enjoyed it. Kids were great.
- SOI is looking to become a STEM partnership school. Found a STEM school in Parma (K-5 only) that we hope to work with.
- 40 letters of invitation to attend the SOI have been sent to upcoming 3rd graders for the 2016-2017 school year. There will be a presentation night at SOI soon.
- Looking to hire teachers for the 7th-8th grade middle school. Already looking at high school classes. Staff is staying busy working on these ideas.
- The SOI website will be updated with presentations, meeting minutes, and other information for parents.

Treasurer's Report - Steve

- Current balance is \$11,500.18.
- Over \$7k in sales for Spring Fundraiser (before expenses). Estimate for expenses so far is \$3k, with both income and expenses increasing as we sell additional tickets.
- We have not made much money on Spiritwear, but that was the idea. The prices were set for this purpose.

• Teacher's holiday luncheon was a big success. We stayed under the \$200 limit.

- No special treatment as far as being invited to SOI. All students MUST qualify or have been picked in the lottery. Nobody can get invited based on knowing someone at the school, having a sibling in the school, or being employed by the school district.
- Two kids returned to their home schools.
- *Member comment: Could a child test in later?* No. The waiting list cannot be changed. If a child is deemed gifted and the waiting list has been made, they will not be able to attend. Other schools in the district have cluster classes for more advanced students that do not or cannot attend SOI.
- *Member comment: Do we have a student council?* Not yet. People have been asking. Haven't had time right now. Teachers are exhausted. Brian is meeting with other 6th grade kids for ideas. Already has plans to meet with SOI 5th graders about this.
- *Member comment: Could the student council be parent led?* Not against this although it does bring its own issues. Do they work on service projects? Does each 'house' have its own leaders? Just need some people to stand up and do it.
- Bill: According to our bylaws, we are supposed to have student reps at these meetings, we just haven't yet.
