SCHEDULE PICK-UP PROCEDURES FOR 2018-19

Parents/students can bring their completed waiver consent forms to the school. Beginning with the 2018-19 school year all emergency forms <u>must be</u> completed on-line. The board office will be sending parents/guardians instructions on how to complete your emergency forms before orientation. Students will then receive their schedule, planner, locker and combination and will be allowed to place their supplies in their lockers. **All forms must be turned in to receive student schedules.**

Please follow the schedule listed below for your student.

Wednesday, August 8th: 6th Grade, WEB Orientation will be held from 8:30-1:00 p.m. A program will be held to familiarize new students with WWMS and WEB leaders will be on hand to mentor new students.

Thursday, August 9th: 8th Grade Schedule Pick-up from 9:00-11:30 a.m.

Thursday, August 9th: 6th Grade Parents "Jump Start" Orientation will be held from 4:00-6:00 p.m.

Friday, August 10th: 7th Grade Schedule Pick-up will be held from 9:00-11:30 a.m. If you cannot attend any of the above dates, paperwork may also be brought into the school at this time.

Note: 7th grade students must have their Tdap and Meningococcal (MCV4) immunizations on file this year. Your pediatrician can fax the information to 440-943-9964 or you may bring it to the school during registration.

Please familiarize yourself with the enclosed information in this packet.

You <u>MUST</u> bring the following paperwork: The Waiver Consent Form and the Emergency Medical Form must be completed online to receive your child's schedule. *Please see the above schedule for all grades.*

If you do not have access to a computer, the Emergency Medical Forms can be completed on a computer at WWMS.

Free/Reduced Lunch and Fee Forms can be completed online or picked up in the office.

WWMS SECURITY GUIDELINES 2018-19

All visitors must follow these security guidelines when coming to Willowick Middle School:

Visitors must enter the school from the main security doors located in front of the school.

All visitors coming into the building will be required to sign-in and present a photo ID (driver's license) to the secretary in the main office. Your driver's license will be returned when you sign out of the building.

If you are picking up your child for an early release, you will remain in the office and he/she will be called down. Please call the office ahead of time if you will be picking up your child.

If someone other than a parent is picking up a student, that person MUST be on the Emergency Forms or we will not release your child.

STUDENT DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP PROCEDURES FOR 2018-19

- Students walking home will go out the front door facing Royalview ES.
- Please follow the prescribed arrows for the pick-up pattern.
- If dismissal has already started when you are entering the parking lot, DO NOT BACK INTO A SPOT.
- Students riding the buses will now be dropped off and dismissed in the back of the school.

IMPORTANT ALERT/EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER REQUEST

Emergency Medical Forms will no longer be sent home for parents to complete. You must go into the PowerSchool program to enter this information.

This number is your **primary contact phone number.** The school will use this number to contact you in case of:

Medical emergency, attendance calls, and all "broadcast" calls, which is a pre-recorded message via telephone.

Your **ALERT** number can be your home phone or a cell phone. It must be a phone number that you will *answer* during school hours.

BOOK BAG/SLING BAG POLICY

Book bags and sling bags <u>CANNOT</u> be carried from class to class. Students may bring their supplies to school in their sling bags and/or book bags, but they <u>MUST</u> be emptied and kept in the lockers during the day.

Only small purses will be allowed to be carried throughout the day.

7TH GRADE TDAP IMMUNIZATION

ALL students in the 7th grade during the 2018-19 school year must have the Tdap and Meningococcal (MCV4) immunizations before school begins in August. You may bring this information in during orientation.

- Parents/students who do not provide documentation of this booster will be subject to exclusion from school.
- ♦ You <u>must</u> present proof that your child has had this immunization.
- Call Mrs. Schwarten, school nurse, at 440-295-2417 or the school office at 943-2950 with any questions.

MEDICATION DISTRIBUTION

Please make sure that completed paperwork is signed by the doctor along with the original prescription and medication bottle.

STUDENT ILLNESSES OR INJURIES

PLEASE DISCUSS THIS VERY IMPORTANT PROCEDURE WITH YOUR CHILD TO ENSURE THEIR SAFETY IN THE EVENT THAT HE/SHE SHOULD BECOME ILL OR INJURED AT SCHOOL.

Students should *immediately* go to the clinic when ill or injured. He/she should NOT call parents using cell phones, which are required to be in your child's locker during the day.

The clinic will call parents to let them know what the situation is and whether parents will need to pick-up their students to take home.

PAY FOR IT PROGRAM FOR LUNCH AND STUDENT FEE PAYMENTS

Instructions on how to set-up a Pay-For-It program account can be found on the W-E Schools website. Please use the parents drop-down menu for instructions.

School fees and student lunch payments can all be made on-line and monitored throughout the school year using the Pay-For-It program.

OUTSIDE STUDENT LUNCHES

Please do not bring in hot lunches/fast food for your child during the day. Bringing outside food into the building poses several problems. Delivering lunches to students when special programs or adjusted bell schedules are in progress is an issue. Food cannot be given to students unless it is their lunch period and food cannot be delivered to or taken into classrooms. If your child forgets lunch, he/she can borrow \$3.10 for a hot lunch for that day. Students are expected to pay back the loan on the next school day.

CHILD FIND PROGRAM

Child Find is an activity conducted by state and local education agencies to locate children age's birth to 21 who have disabilities. The purpose of the program is to provide special education and related services that are needed. Disabilities may include developmental delays in communication skills, motor skills, or social emotional/behavior functioning. A student is considered disabled if they have one or more of the following conditions: Autism, deaf-blindness, hearing impairment, brain injury, learning disabilities, emotional disturbance, or a speech or language impairment.

If you know of any child who has or may have special needs, please contact Mrs. Eileen Bowers, Office of Pupil Services, Willoughby-Eastlake City Schools at 440-975-3800. Once notified, the school district will contact the parent/guardian to find out if the child needs to be evaluated. The evaluation will be provided free of charge and, if eligible, the child will receive appropriate special education and related services.
