### ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY- FALL SPORTS

In order for students to be eligible for fall sports, either at Willowick Middle School, North High or South High Schools, they must meet academic eligibility rules. **Students must have an overall Grade Point Average for the 4<sup>th</sup> Grading Period of at least 2.0.**

Students below 2.0 will be on probation until grades are improved. In addition, students who fail two subjects are ineligible, even if their overall grades are high enough. **Please note that final grades are not considered...only 4<sup>th</sup> quarter grades determine eligibility!**

### PAYING ATHLETIC FEES...

Please go to the Athletic website during the year for information regarding sporting events, dates, times and updates. If your student is full pay, you must go on Final-Forms to pay athletic fees.

If your student is on free or reduced lunches/fees, you will need to pay athletic fees directly to your child's coach.

### Year-End Medication/Supplies

All unused **MEDICATION/SUPPLIES** should be picked up by May 23rd (the last day of school). Any medication/supplies remaining after May 23rd will be discarded.

Please contact the school nurse at 440-295-2417, or look on the W-E website under the Parent Page/Health Services for medication forms for the 2018-19 school year. Also, please inform the school nurse of any medical conditions your child may have that needs to be addressed for the 2018-19 school year.

### Tdap and Meningococcal Immunizations for 2018-19 Mrs. Schwarten, R.N.

At the beginning of May, WE Schools will send (has sent) a letter regarding the Tdap and the Meningococcal Immunizations to all families that will have students entering the 7th grade in the 2018-19 school year. **Please read this letter carefully and call WWMS clinic at 440-295-2417 with any questions.**

The state of Ohio requires that all 7th grade students have the Tetanus, diphtheria and Acellular Pertussis booster (Tdap) and now requires that students have the Meningococcal Immunizations before school begins in August.

If your child has received these immunizations, have your pediatrician complete that form. You may bring this information in during orientation or the immunization records may also be faxed to WWMS at 440-943-9964.

- Students who do not provide documentation of these immunizations will be subject to exclusion from school.
- You **must** present proof that your child has had this immunization.

The Lake County Health District provides childhood immunizations. Call 440-350-2554 or 440-350-2434 for information or to schedule an appointment at the Painesville location.

### LIBRARY BOOKS

A re-bind fee to repair textbooks with extensive damages (beyond normal wear and tear) may also be charged. Students are given a copy of the charges to take home. It is your child's responsibility to bring these fee slips home.
