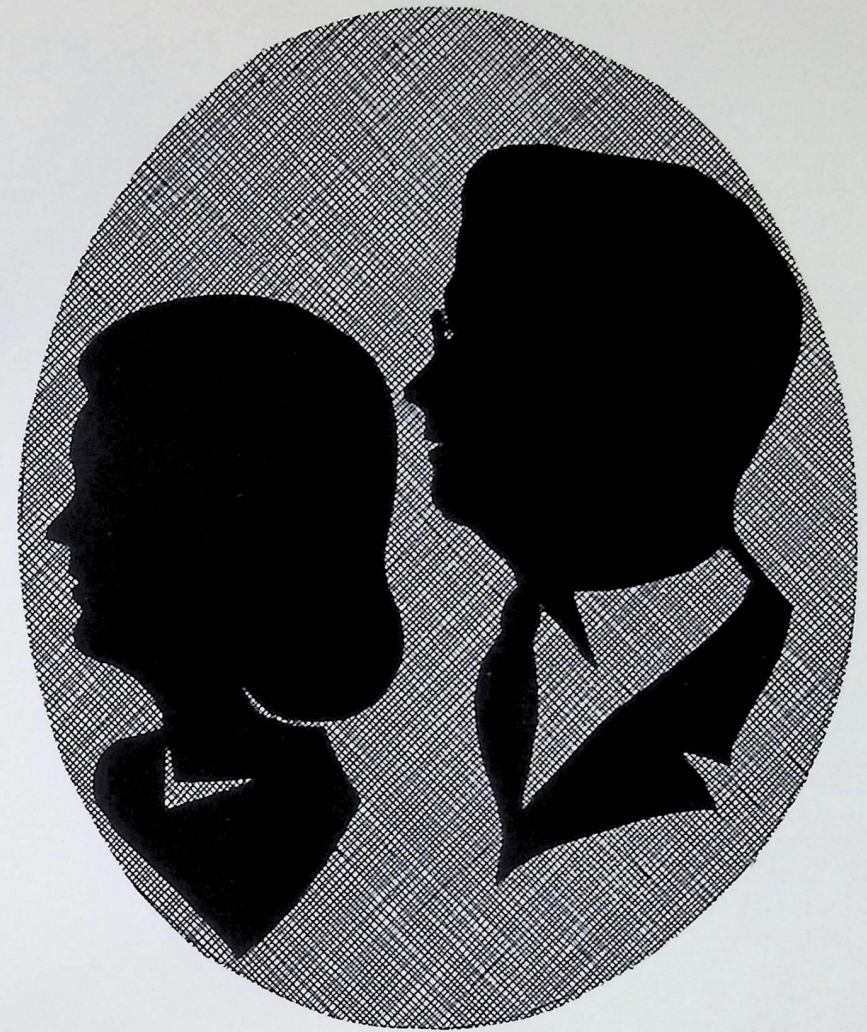

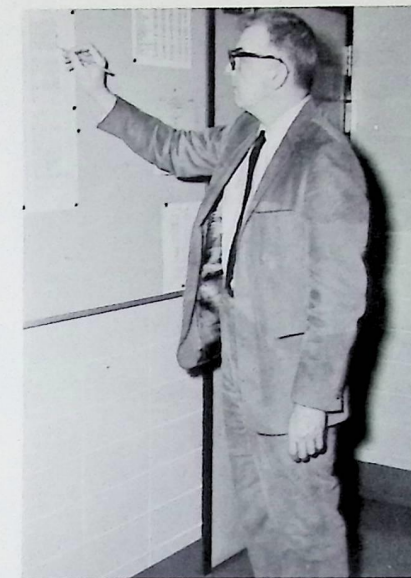
BOARD OF EDUCATION
