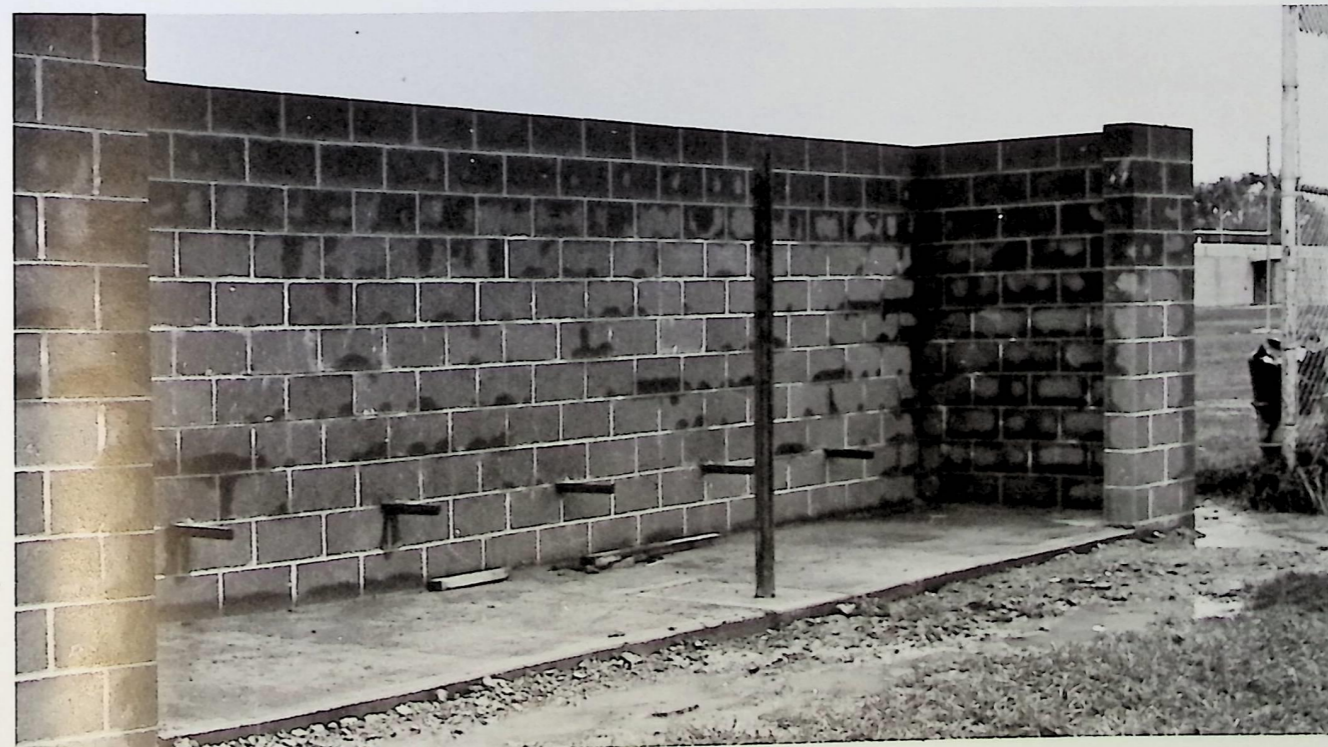
Campus Improvements

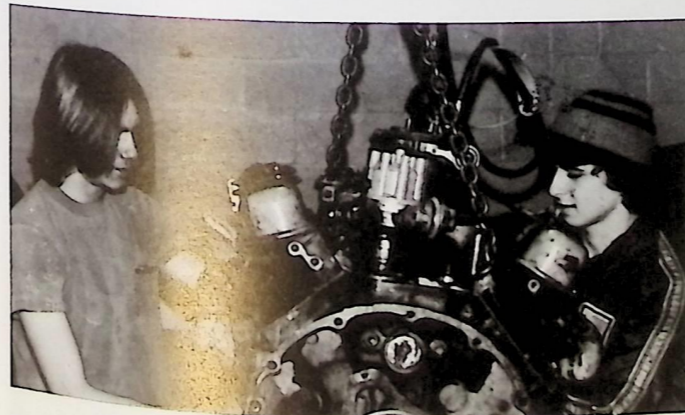
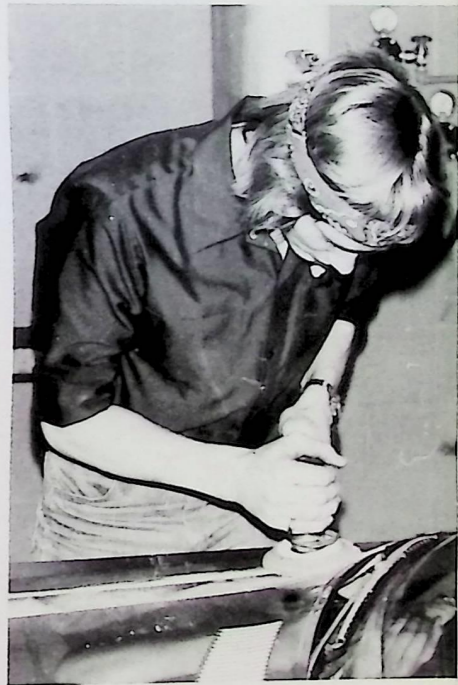


SOPHOMORE CLASS ACTIVITIES

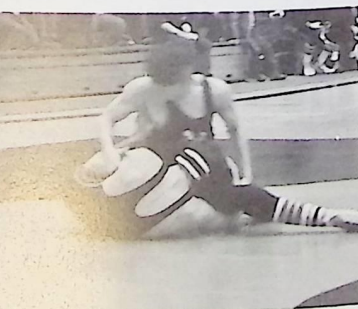
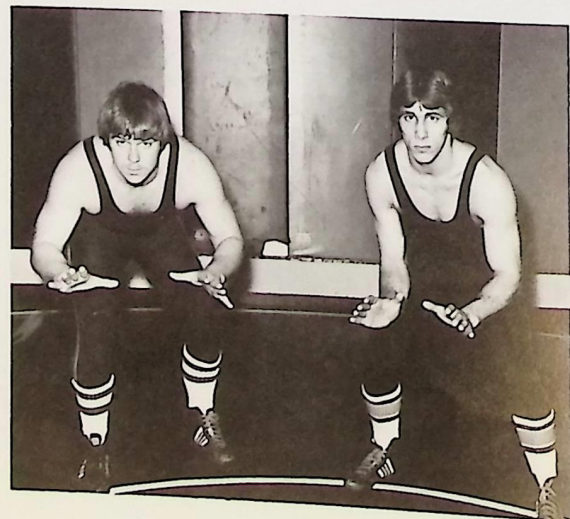
WRESTLING (VARSITY AND J.V.)

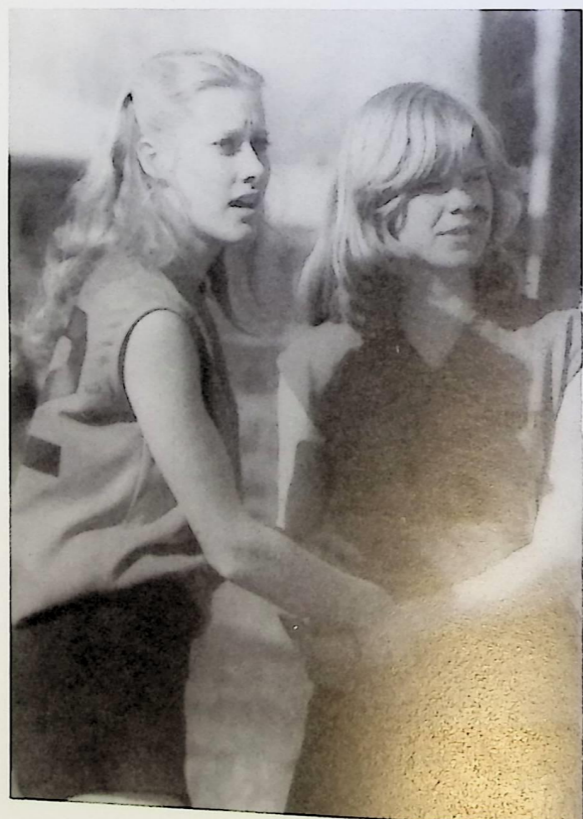




GIRLS THINCLADS 1978

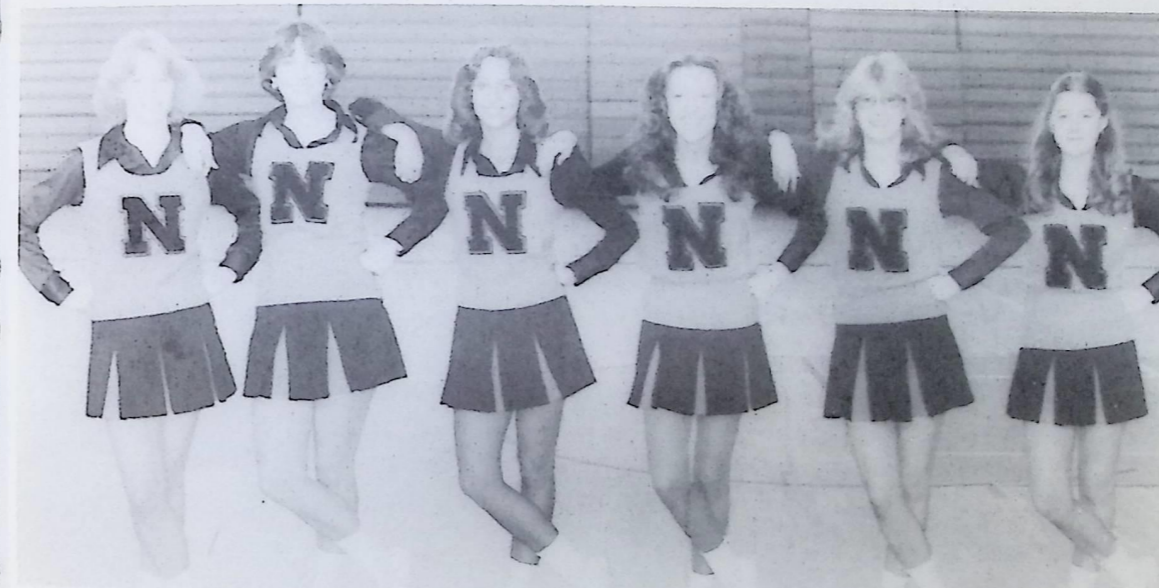
Matteucci Hits

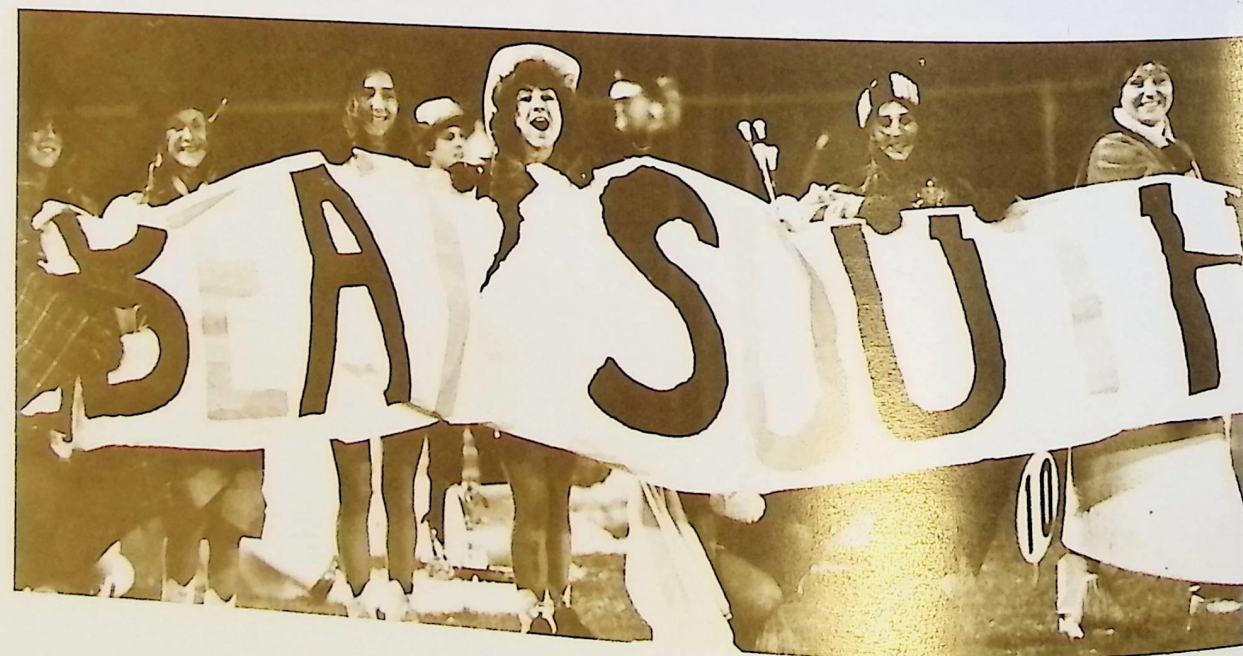
Mr. Everson has put an endless amount of time and effort into his work. His final production "The Pirates of Penzance" was his way of saying farewell to North High School.
