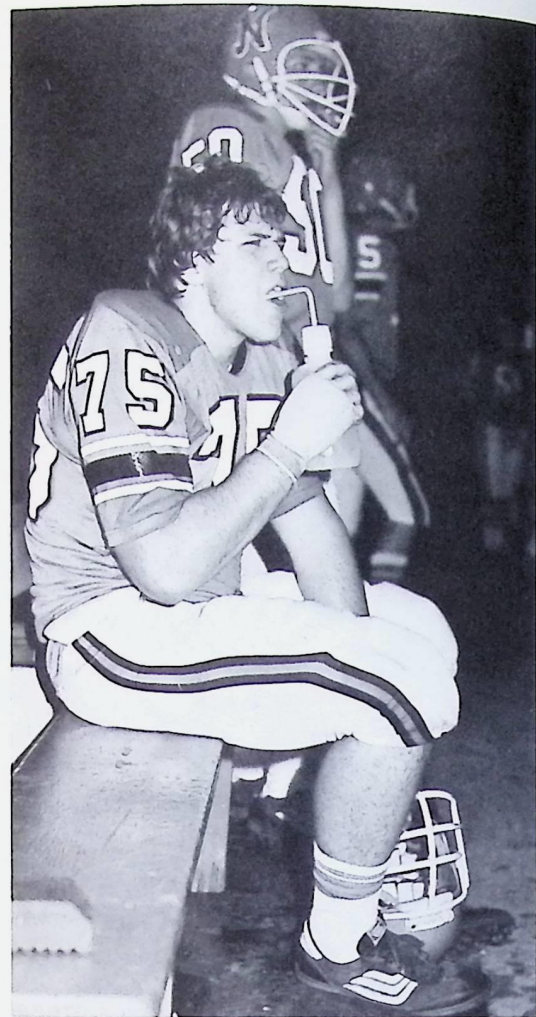


## Through The Past

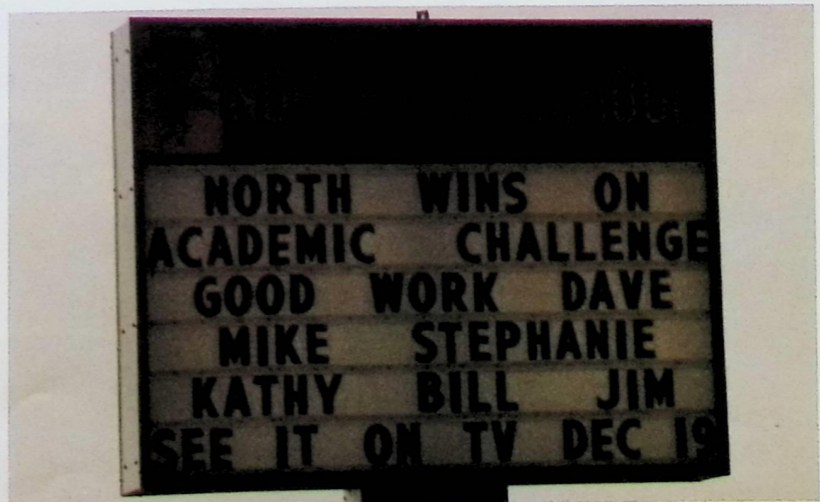
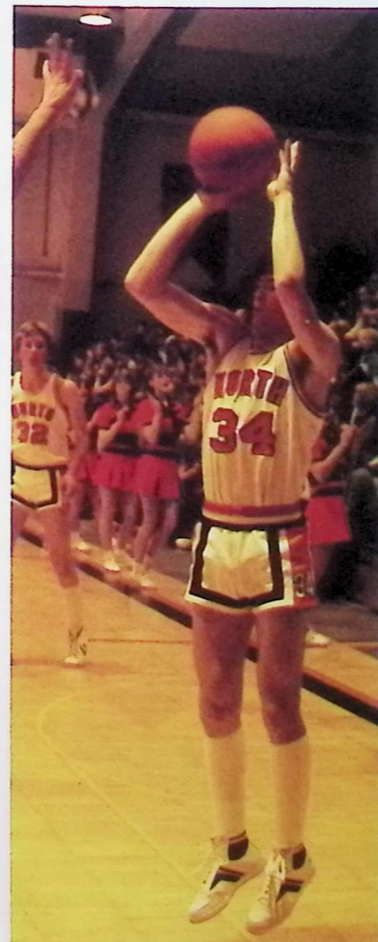
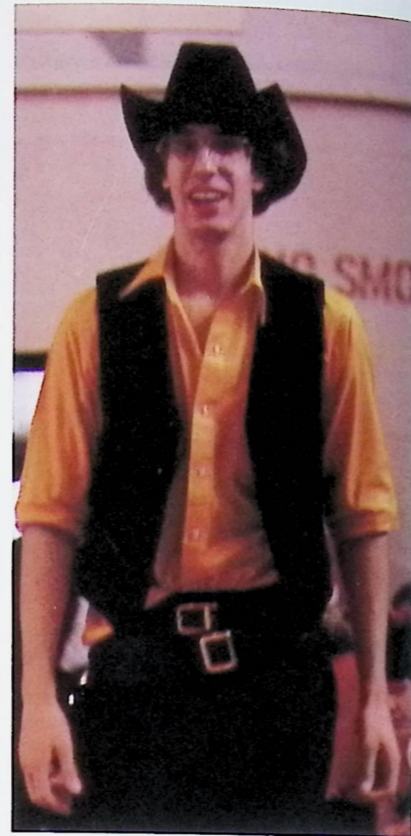

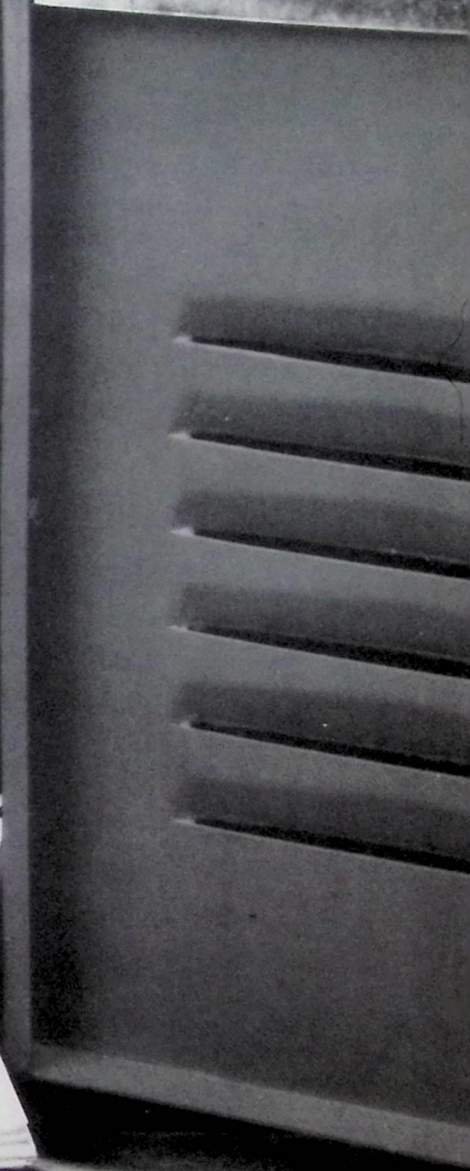
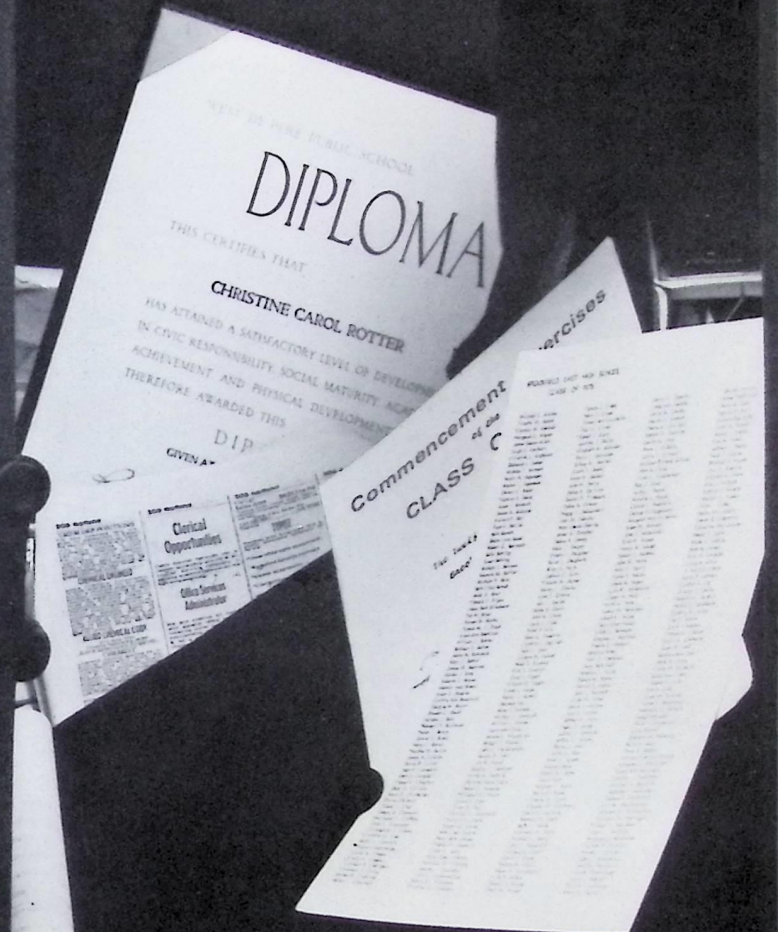
## Into The Future

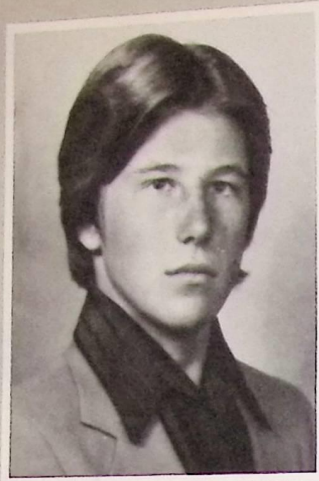

## Rangers Booters Break Records, Win Title

The 1981 Ranger soccer team captured yet another trophy to dazzle the eyes of North fans. Under the guiding hand of the amiable Vic St. Hilaire, the Ranger booters blasted their way to a 13-4-2 record and a slice of the GCC Championship.

The team started the season slowly, winning only two of the first six games. However, the cowboys went on to set a school record by winning the next eleven games and tying one before losing in the sectionals. During this streak they scored 53 goals and allowed only 17. The 7-1-2 conference record resulted in a co-championship with Brush, the pre-season favorite. 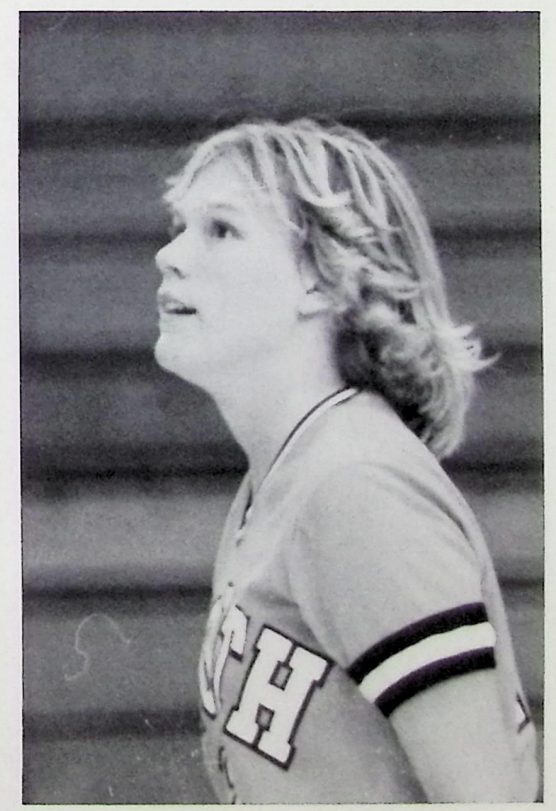

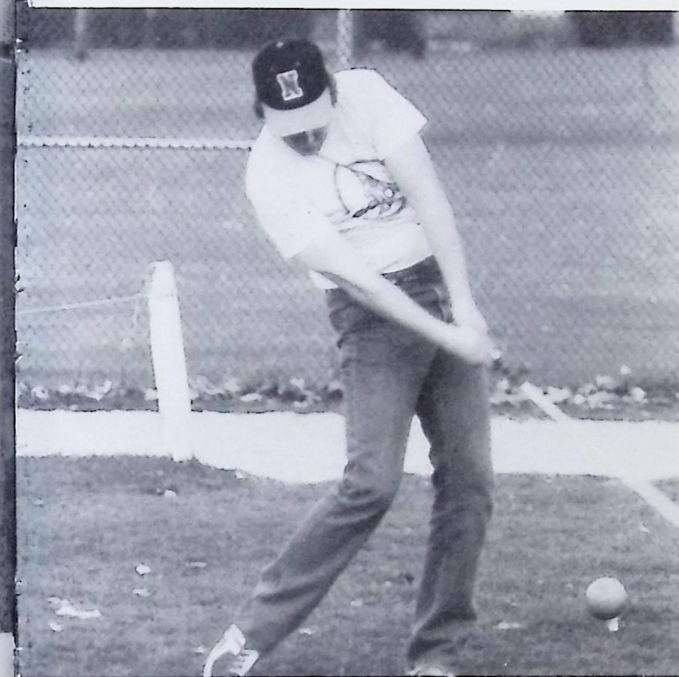

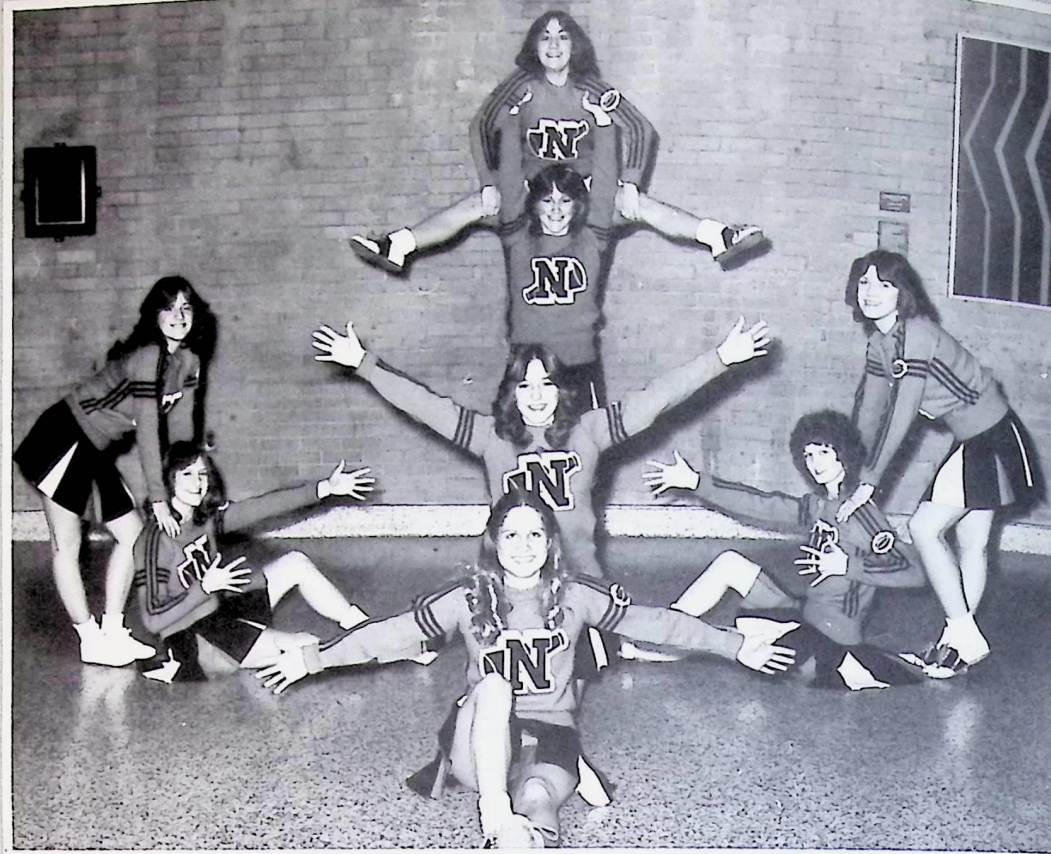
**VIC CALLS LAST PLAY, RETIRES AFTER 25 SEASONS**

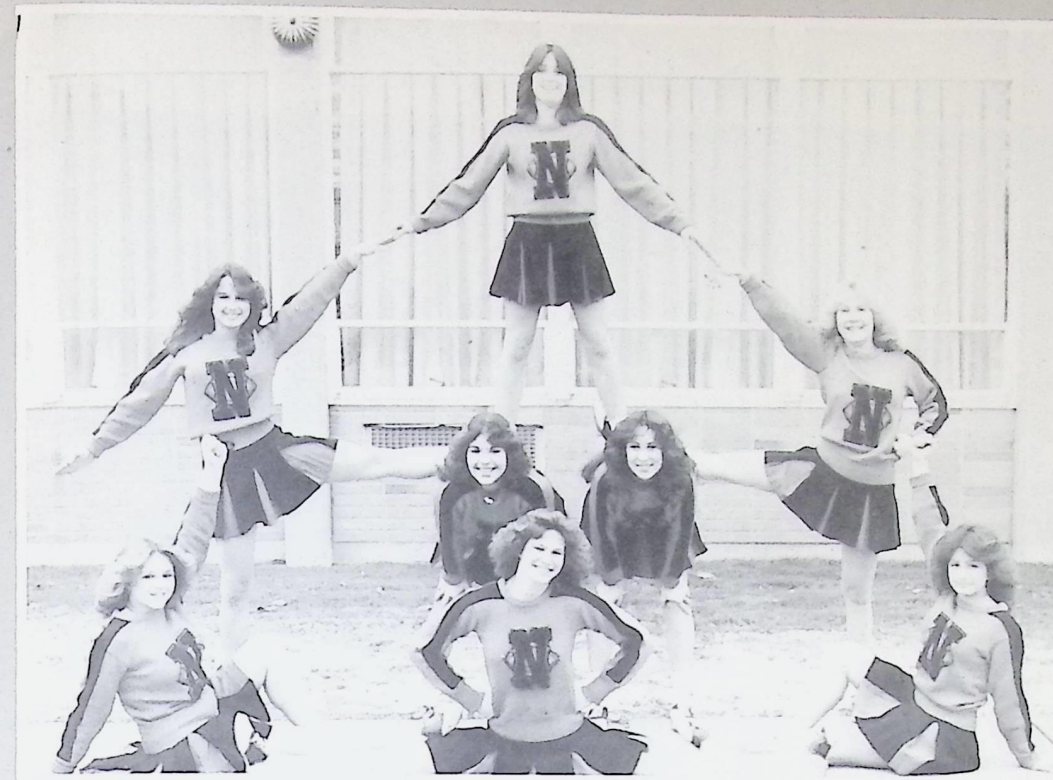

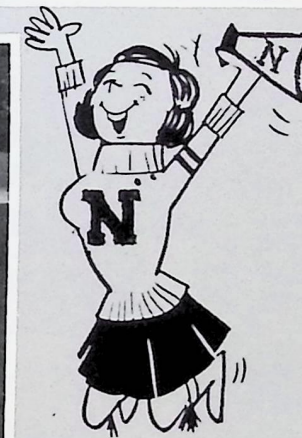

**Mary Petrecca:** Senior, forward. One of the top players in state. MVP - GCC and team. All-State UPI & AP. Cleveland area All-Star selection.

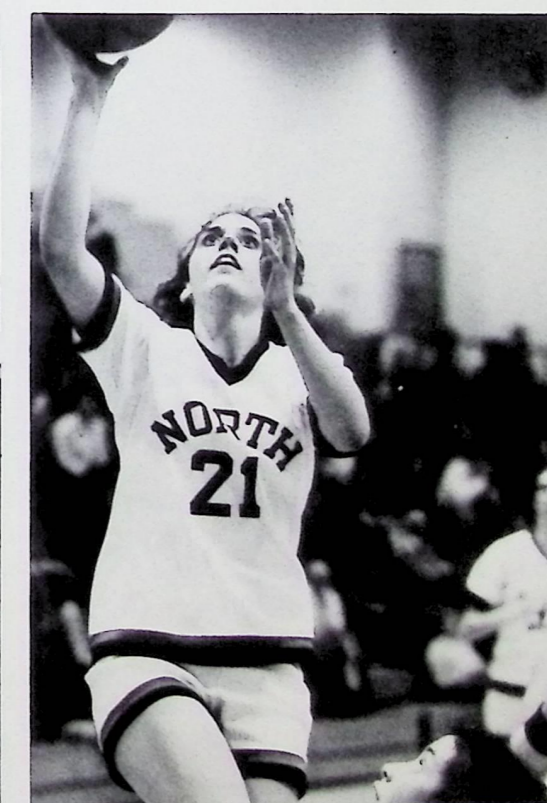
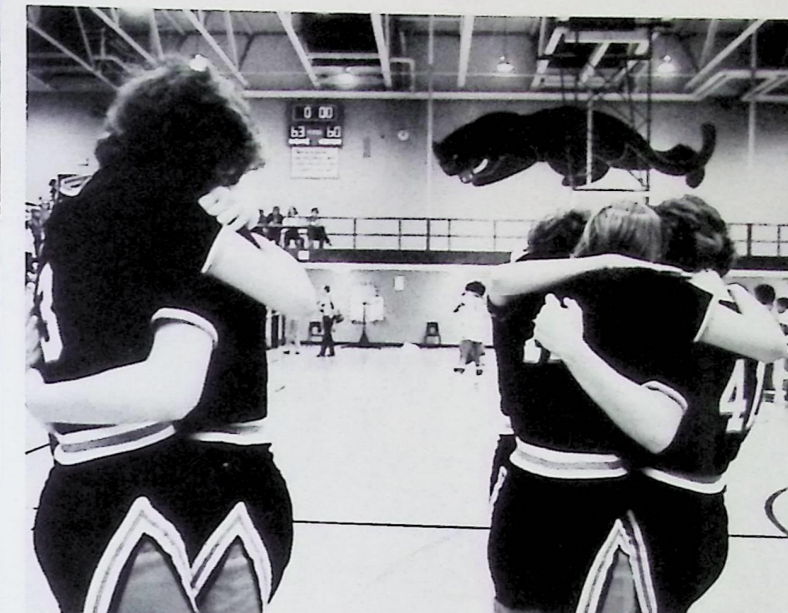
**Claudia Euse:** Junior, guard. The spark off the bench. Would have started on any other team.

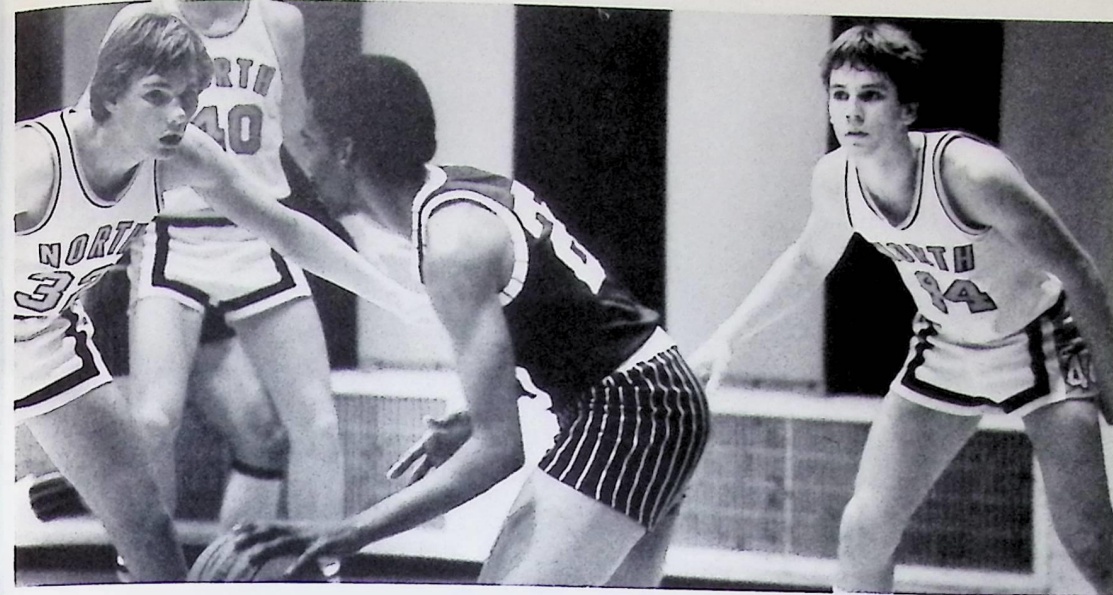

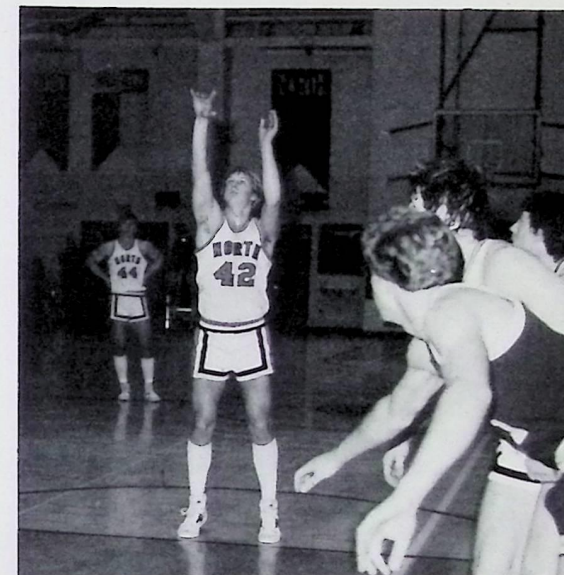

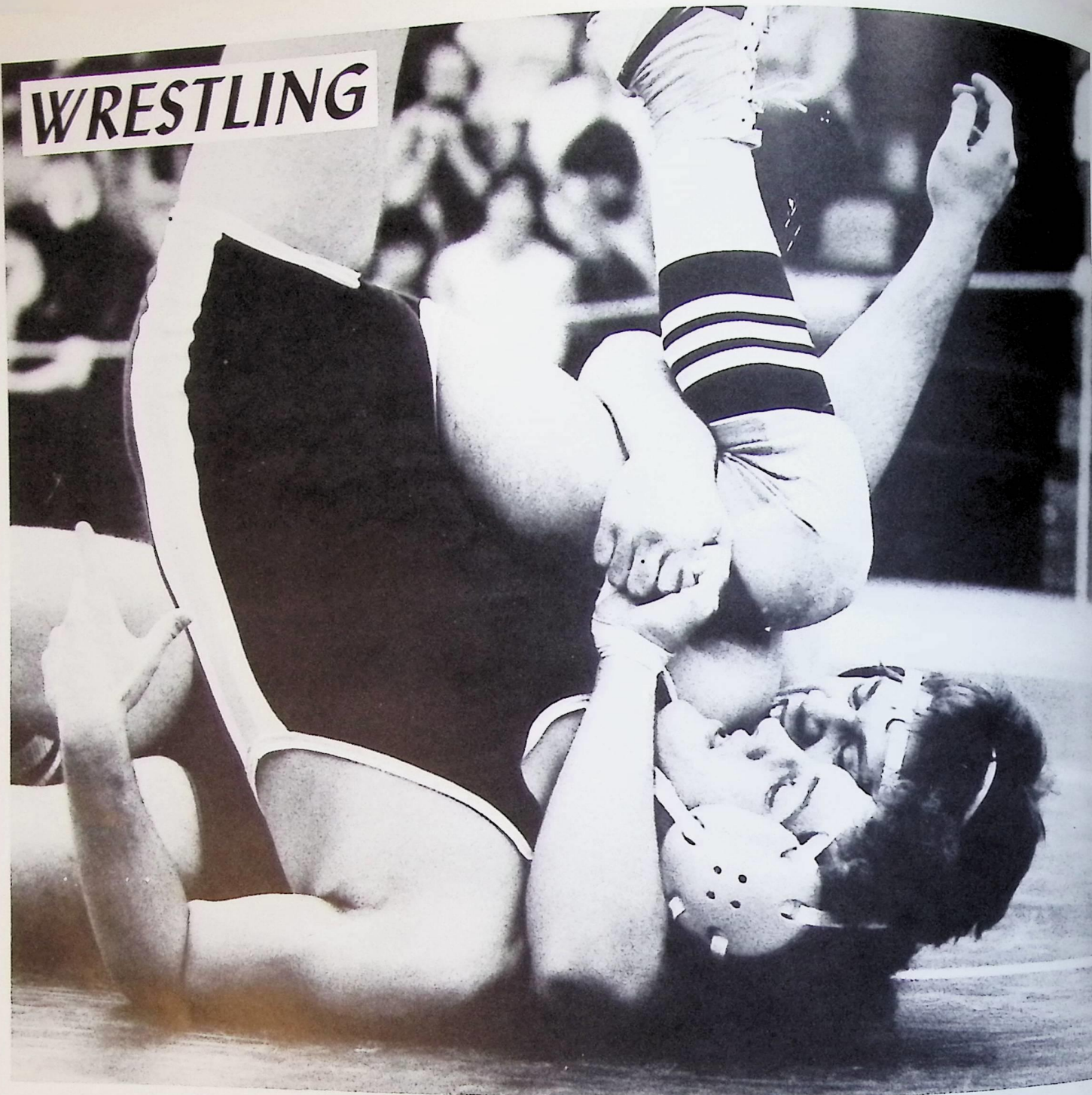

## Hard Work Pays Off for Matmen

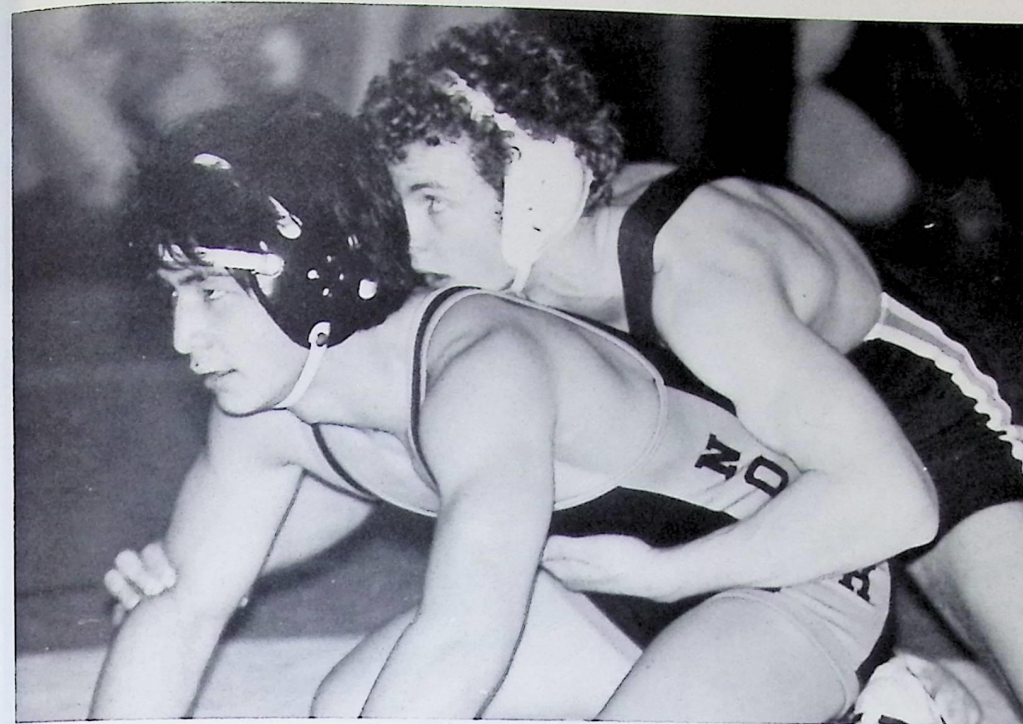

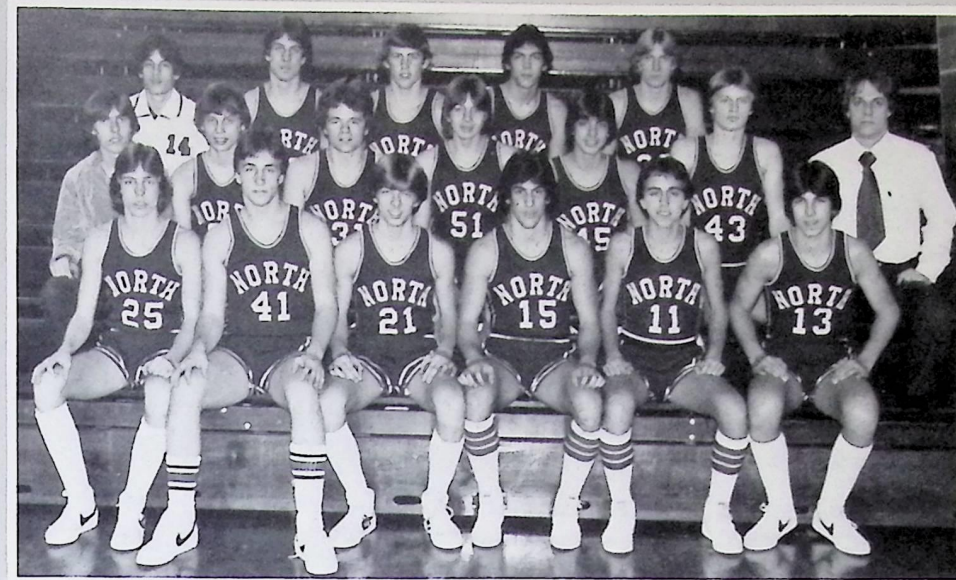

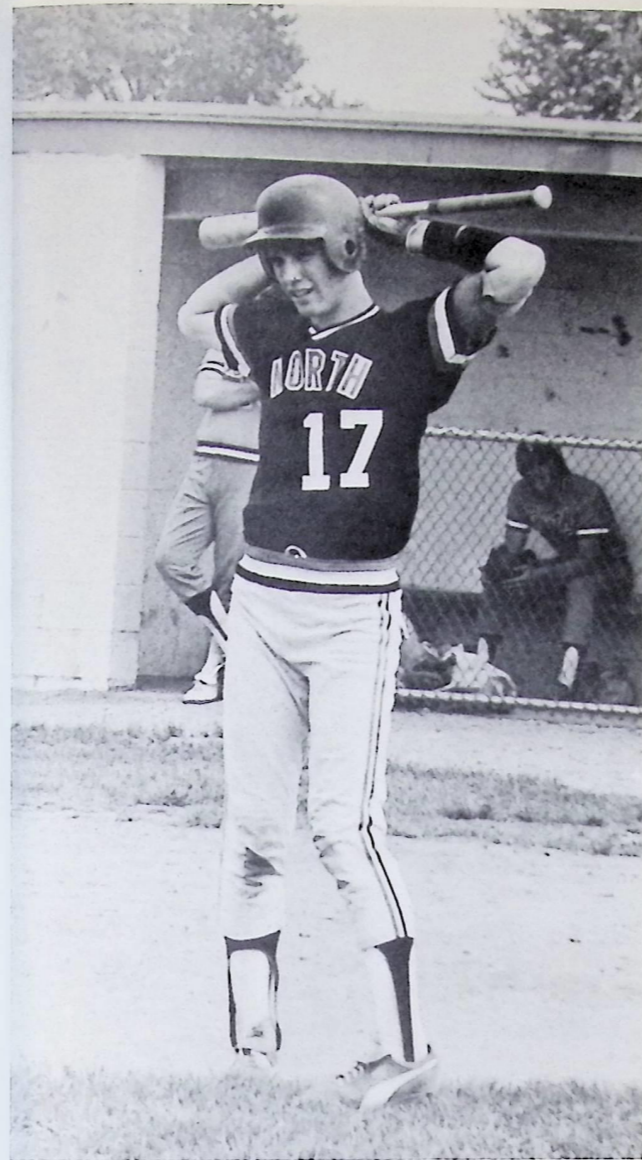
### Rangers Have Winning Season; Three Get Tri-C Honors

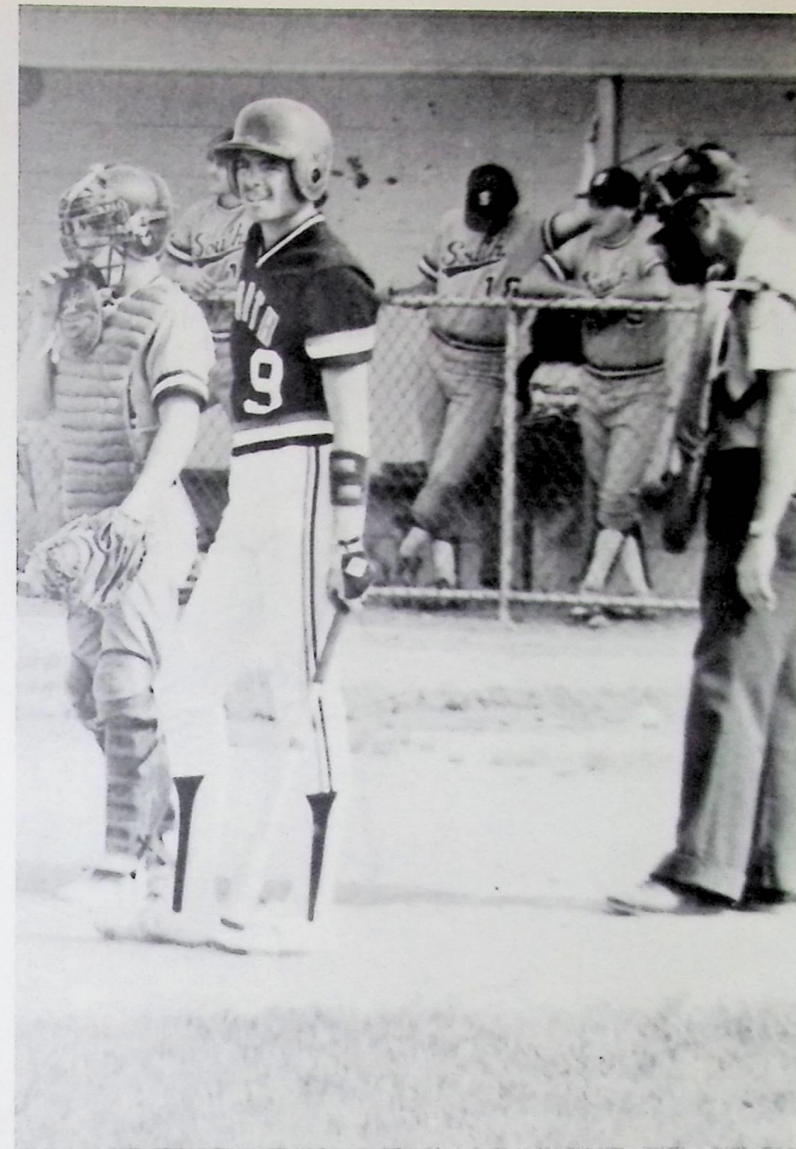
Seniors Larry Kucharski and Jim Foegen were the team's MVPs. Larry, in his second year as a starting

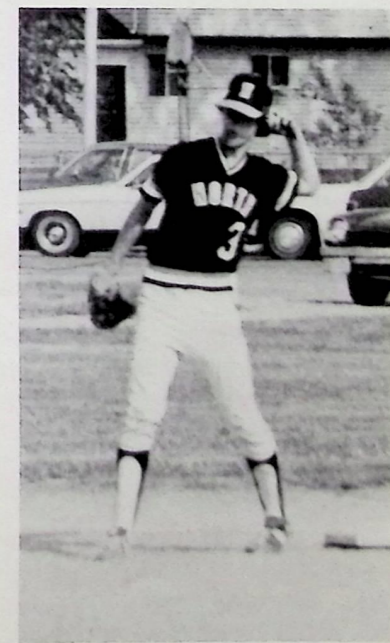
Jim Smalley stretches out before a trip to the plate.

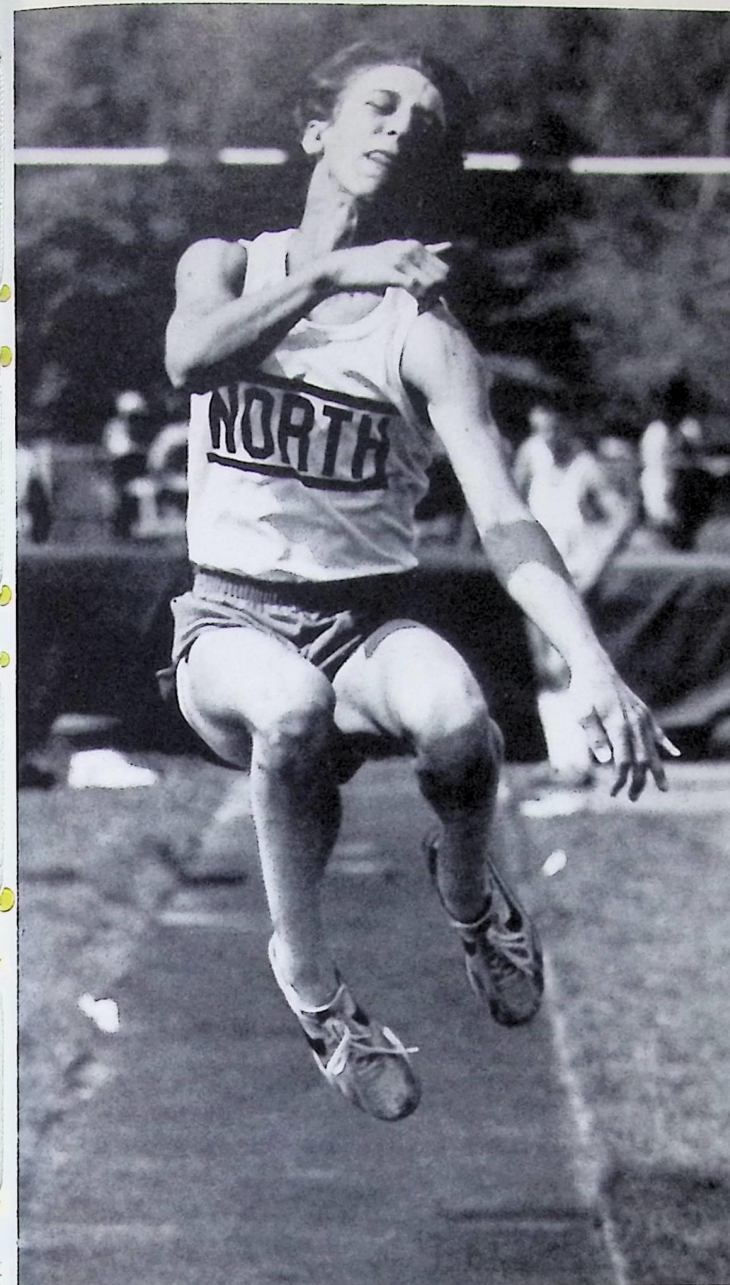

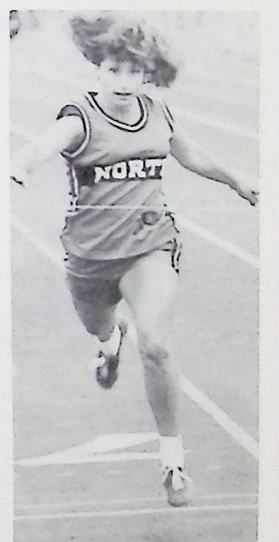

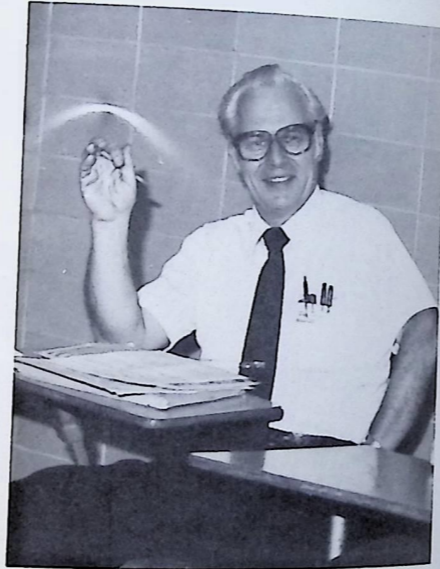
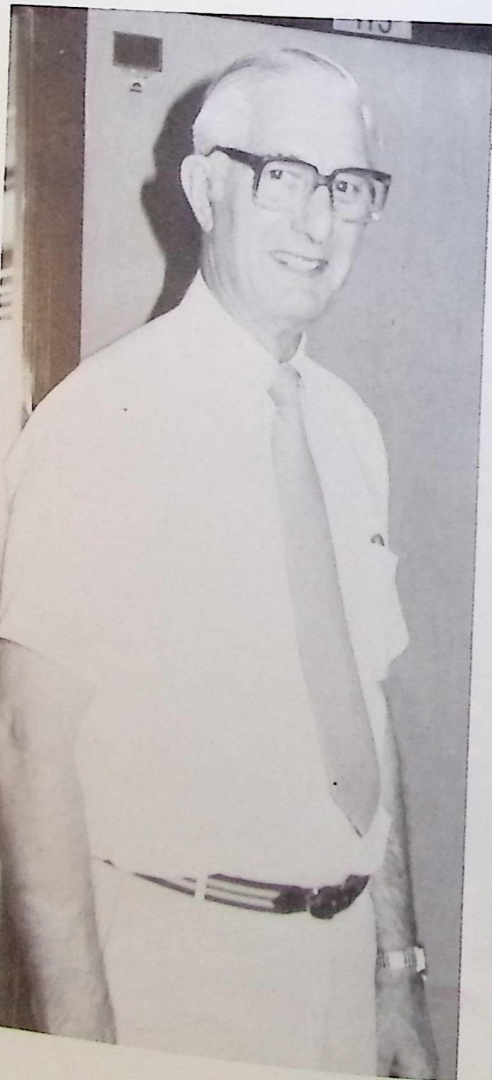


# NORTH BIDS GOOD-BYE TO OLD FRIENDS
