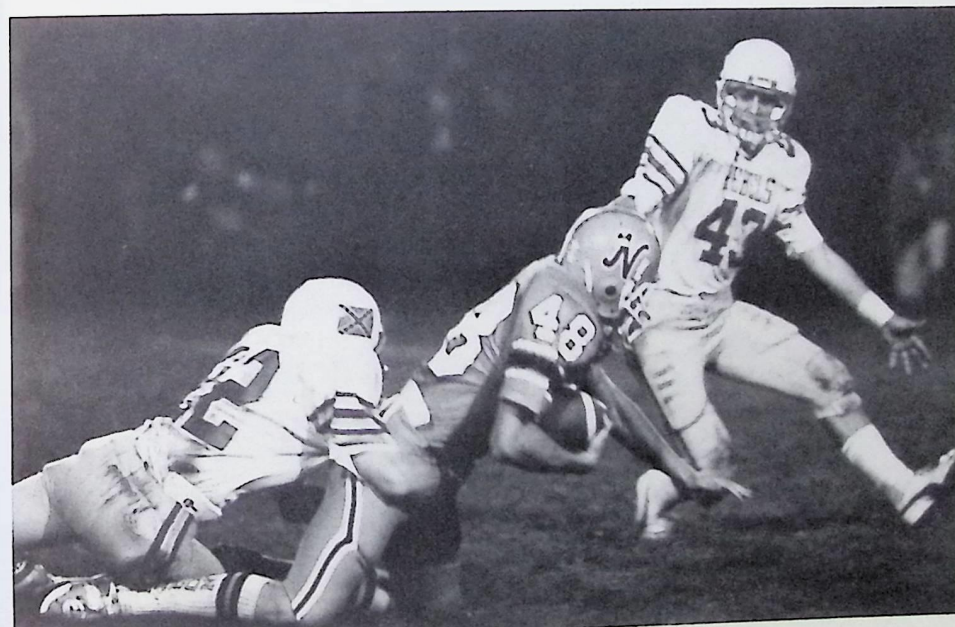
122 Easily the high point of the season was the

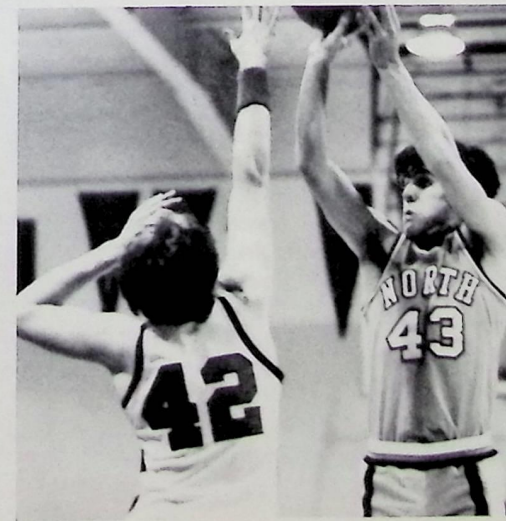
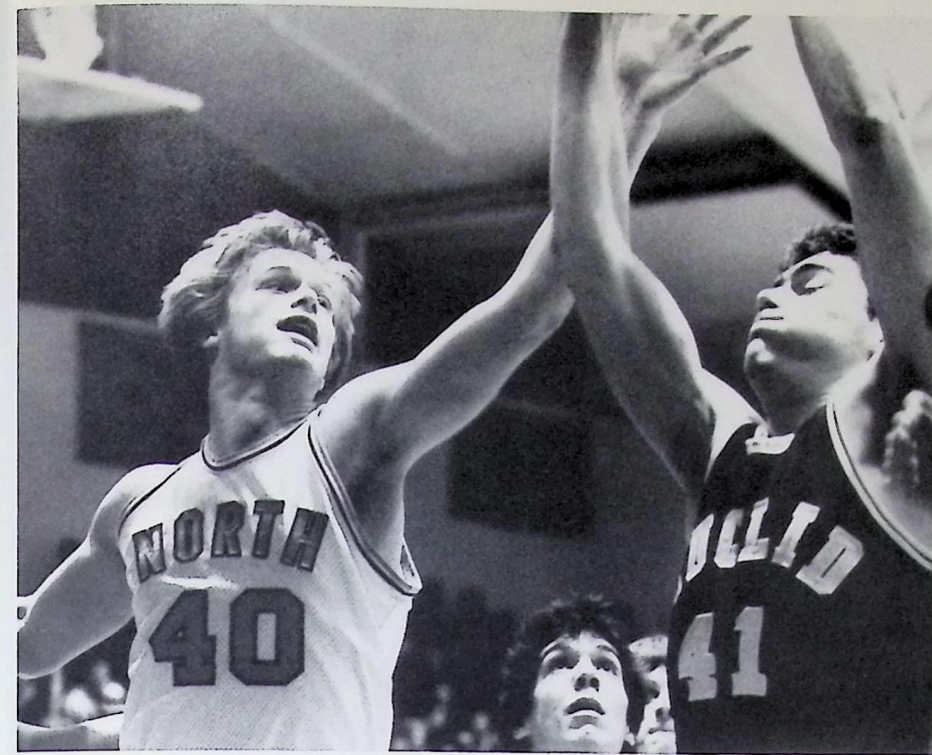
### Smiley's 22.5 Average Leads Team To 11-9 Season

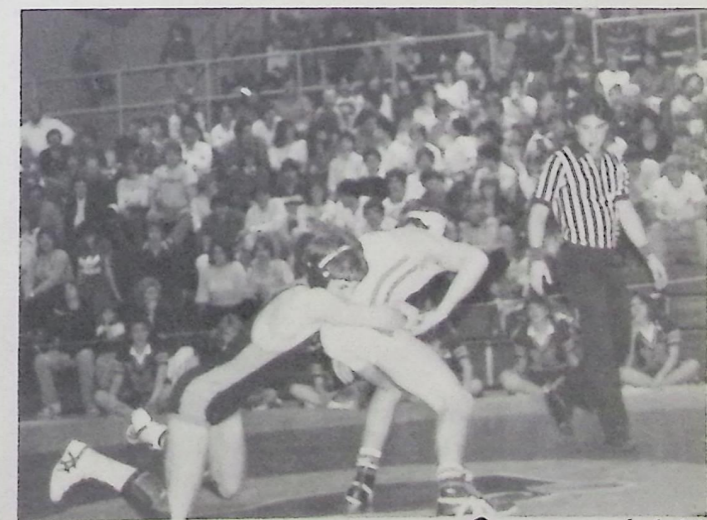
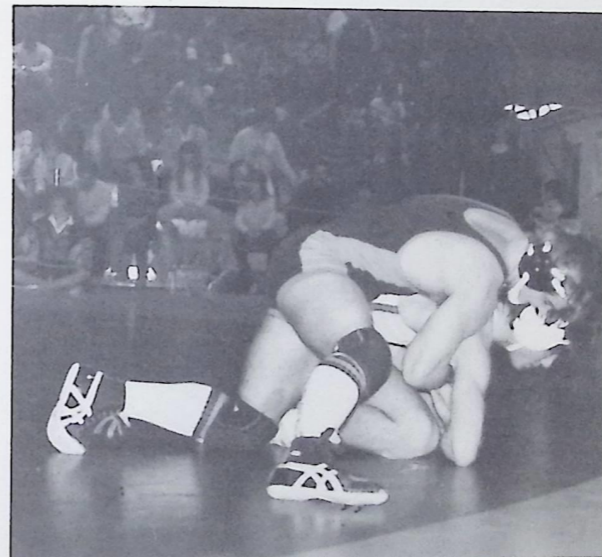
## North Matmen Grapple With Trying Season

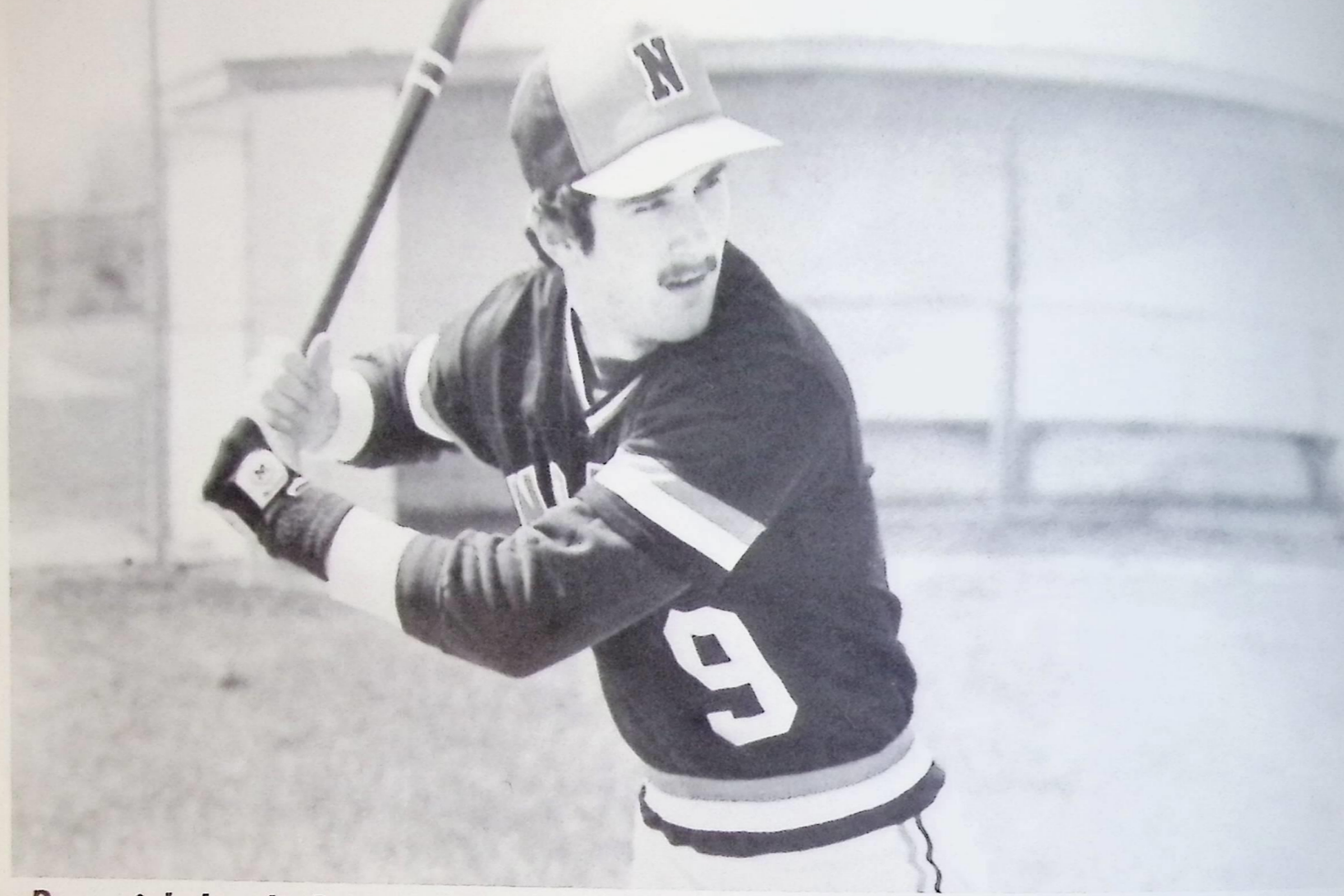

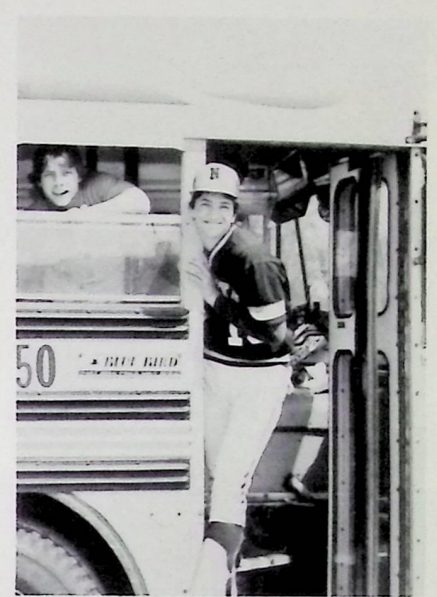
## Popovich Leads Rangers To Districts

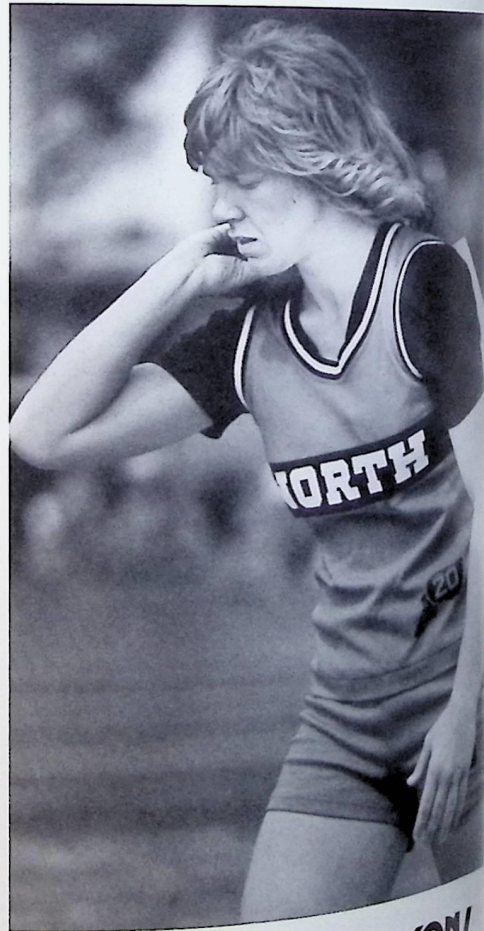
## GIRLS' TRACK

## FAREWELL TO THE CHIEF



### Mr. Holloway Bows Out After Thirty Years

During this past school year, Mr. Arthur Holloway, an integral part of the Willoughby-Eastlake Schools for over thirty years, resigned as Superintendent. Reflecting on his accomplishments over the years makes it easy to see why this enthusiastic educator was the Ohio PTA'S selection for Outstanding Educator of the Year. In 1968 as a neophyte superintendent, Holloway was faced with the difficult task of reshaping the school system. One of his first undertakings was Vocational Education. Consequently, the renovated Willoughby Union High School, now called the Tech Center, was established as the vocational focal point. In addition, the school district became one of the first systems in the state to train handicapped youth, and a "Back to Basics" reading program has led to students scoring higher on standardized tests. Indeed, Holloway's "What's best for the kids" philosophy is still evident throughout the district.
