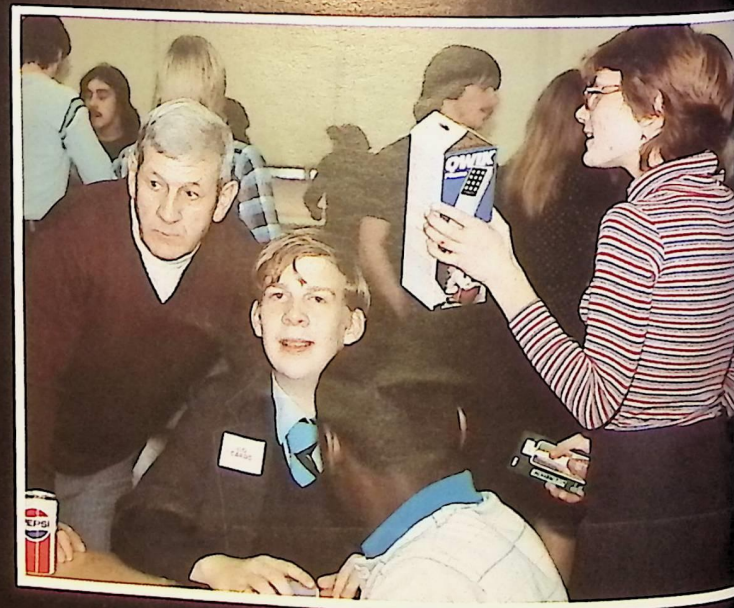
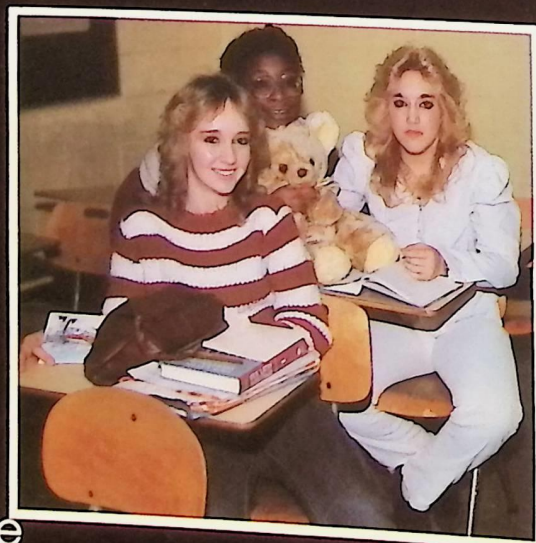
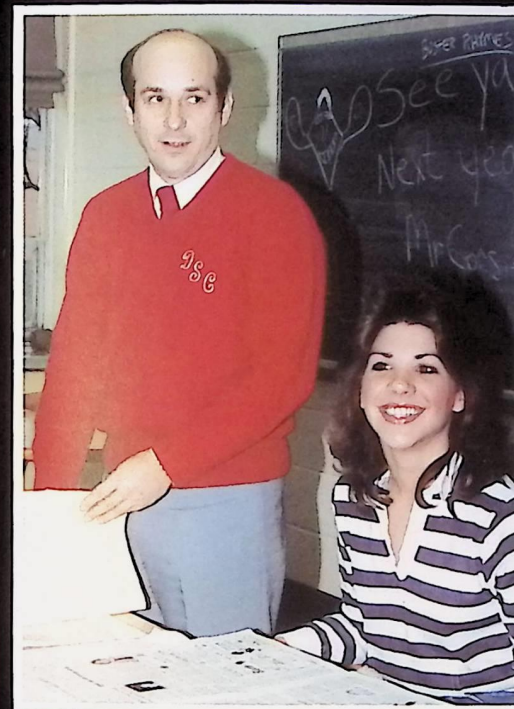
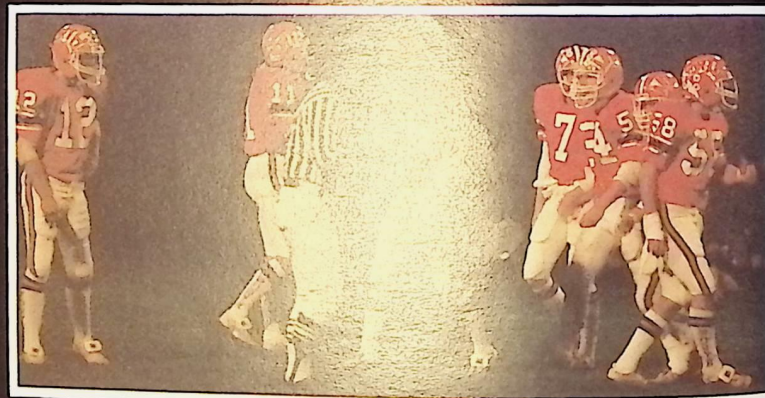




MISSION: To undertake extensive studies leading to knowledge of the average "teen" through observation conducted at "North", an educational facility attended regularly by the aforementioned species.

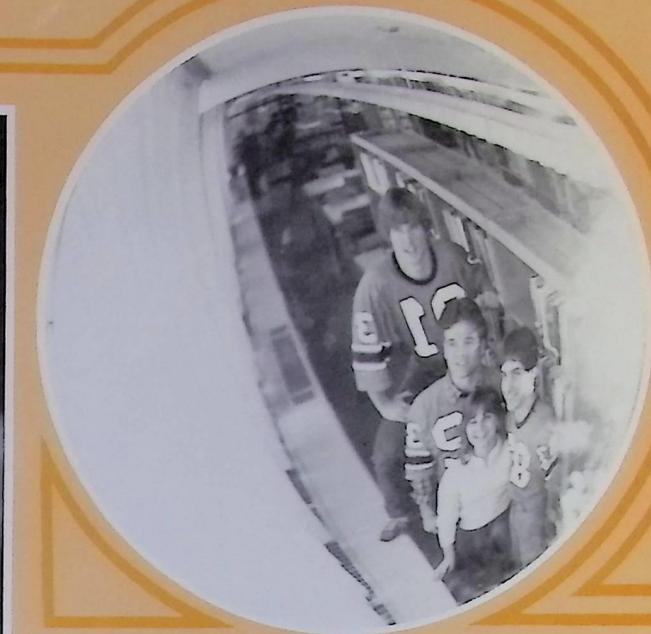
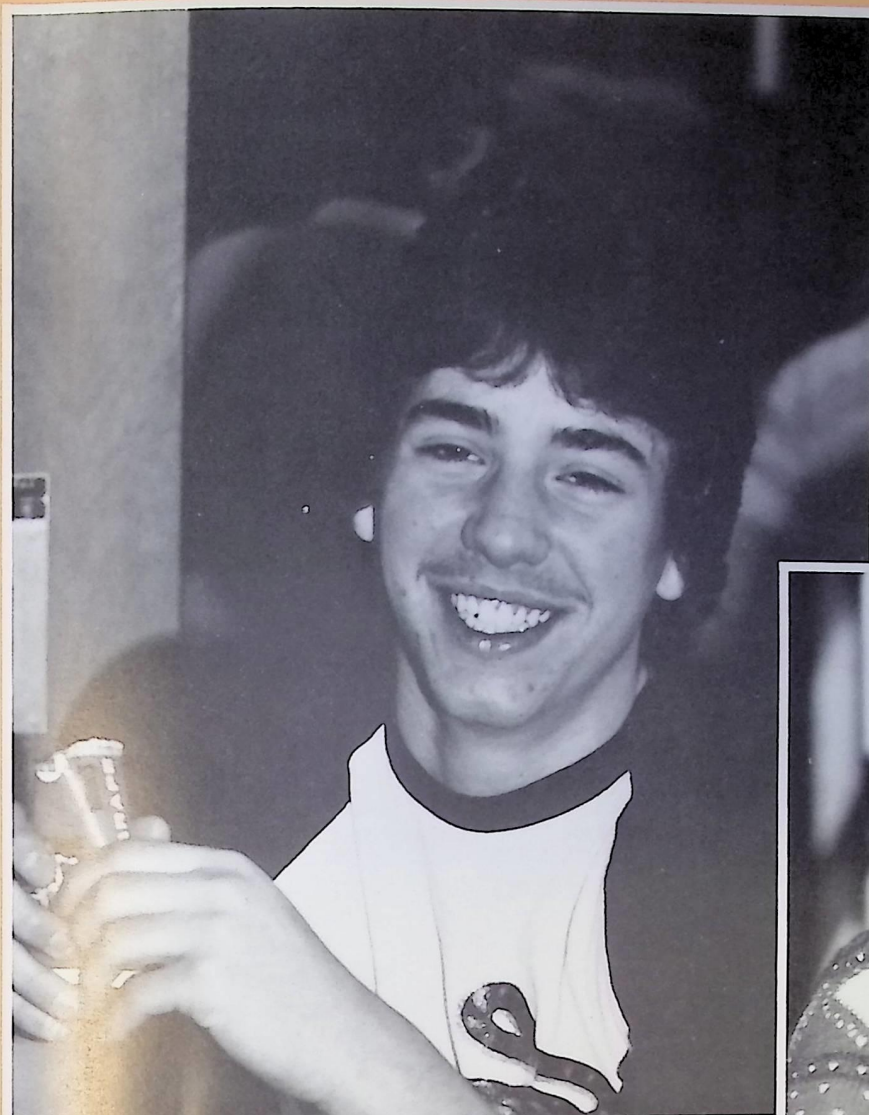


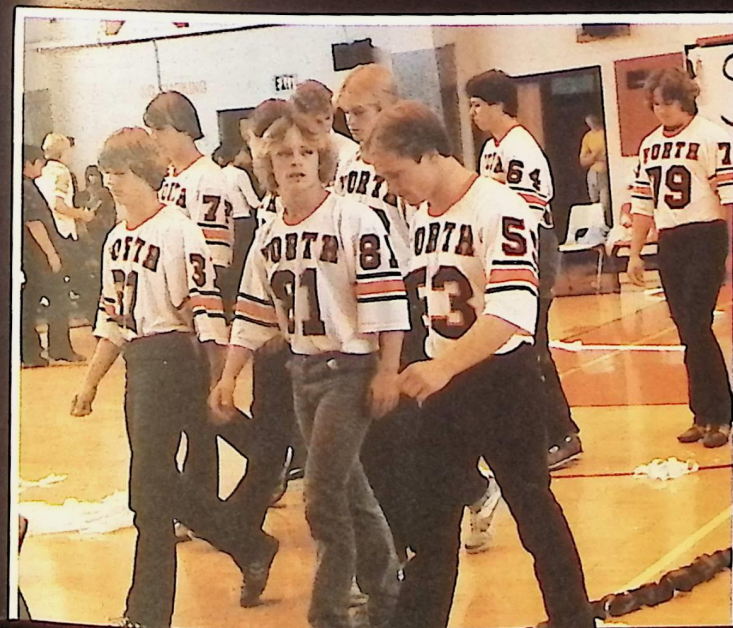
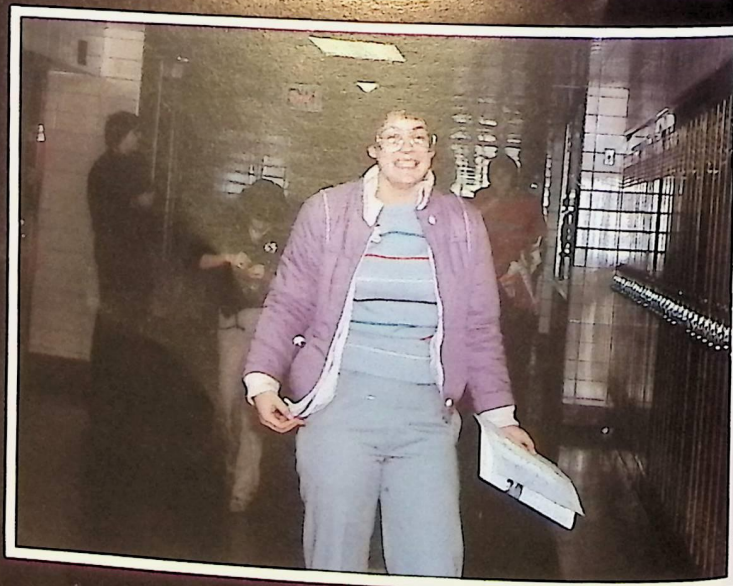
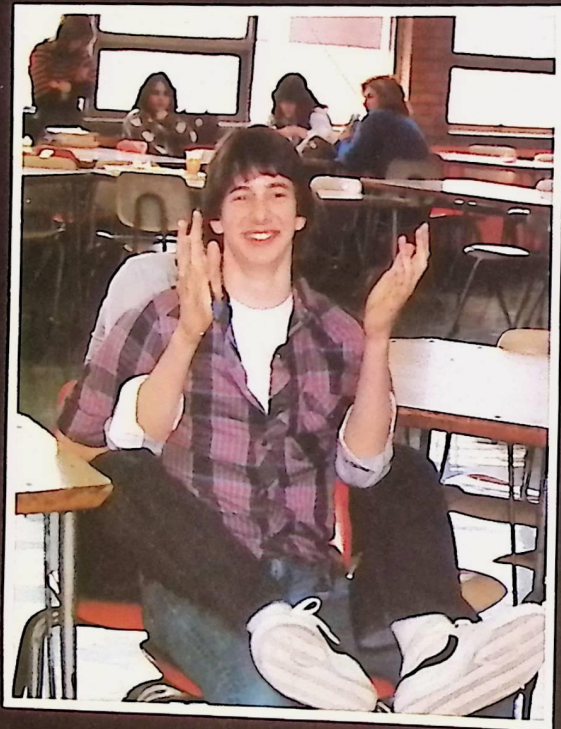
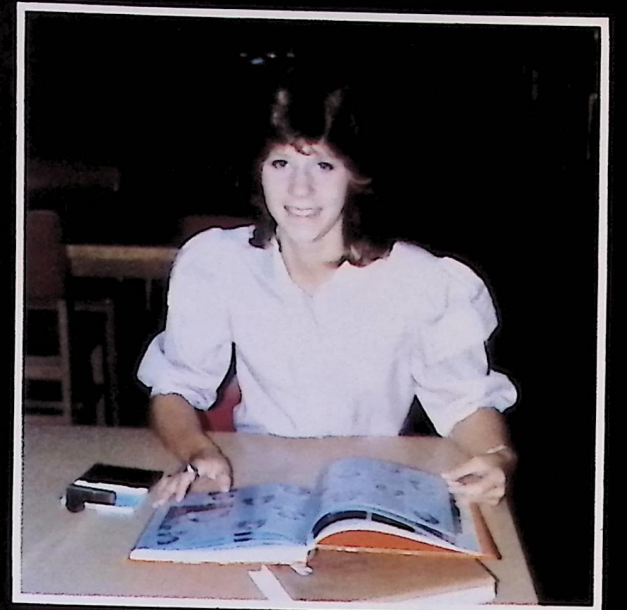
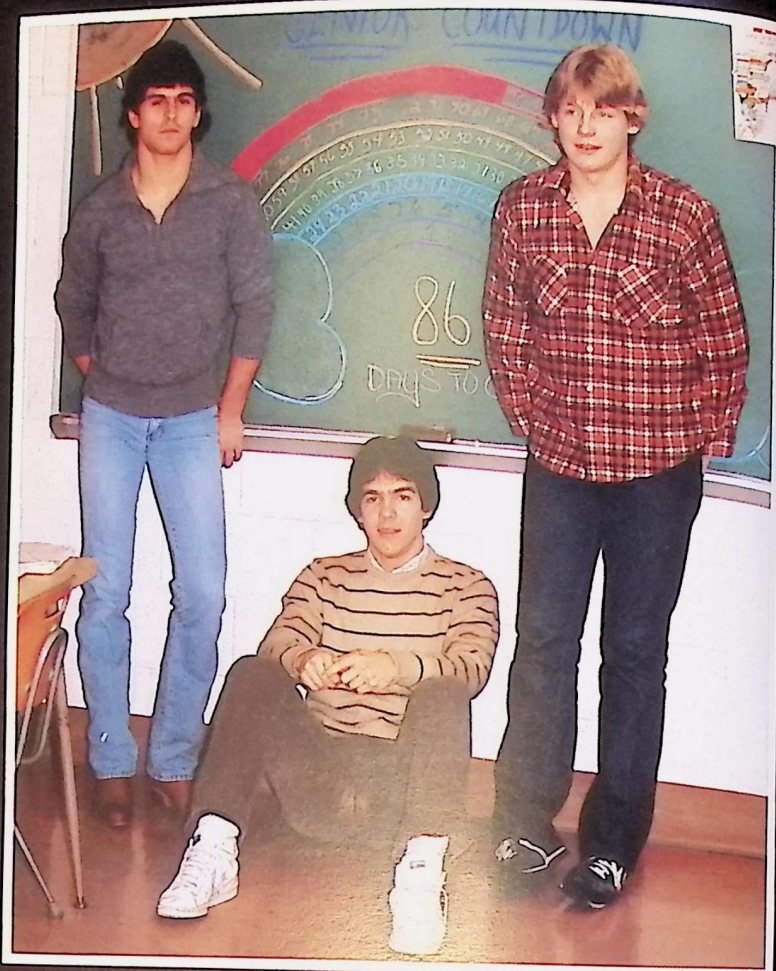
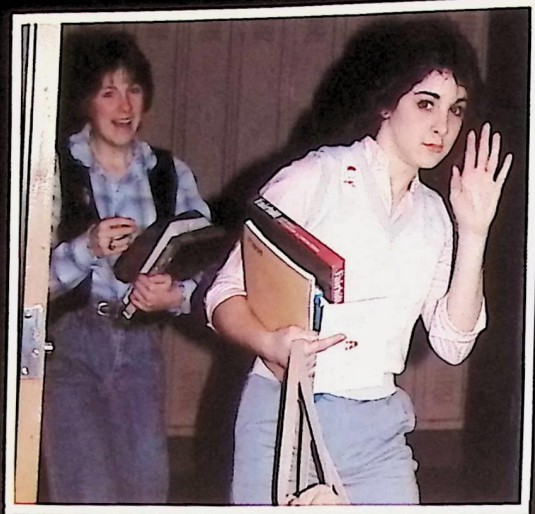


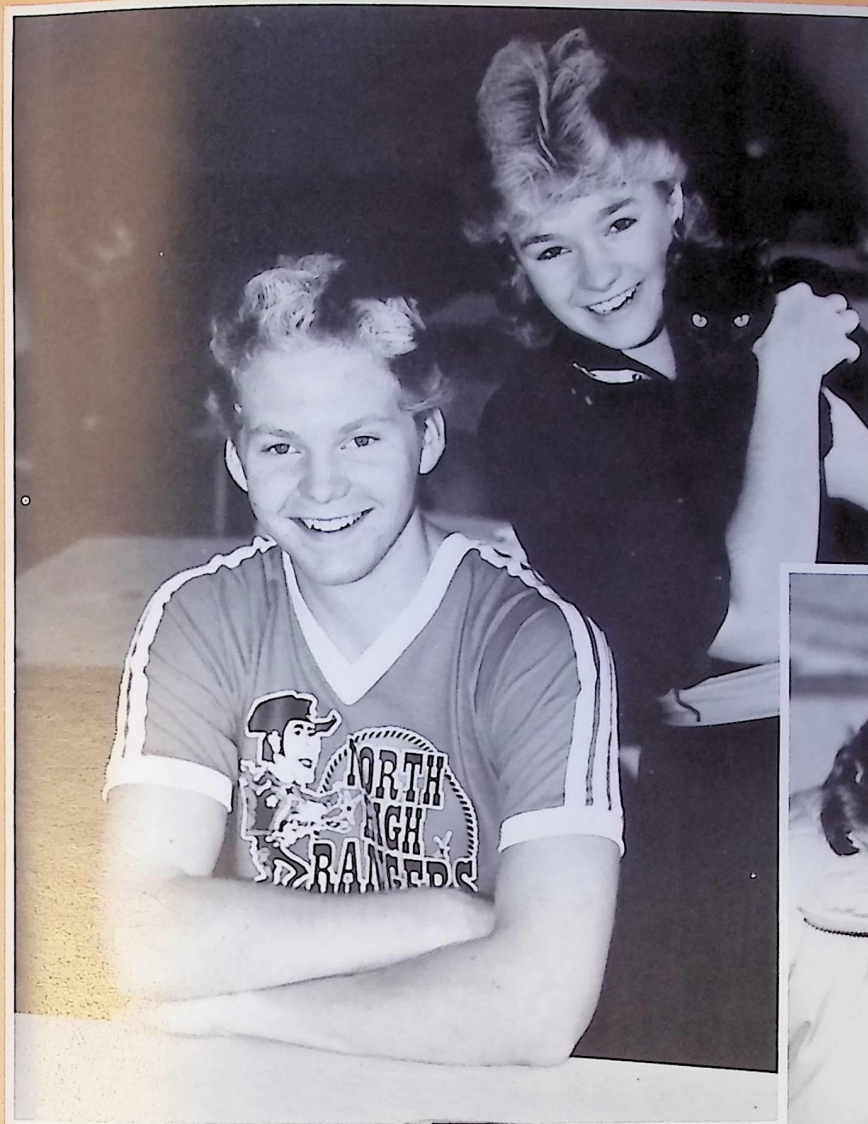
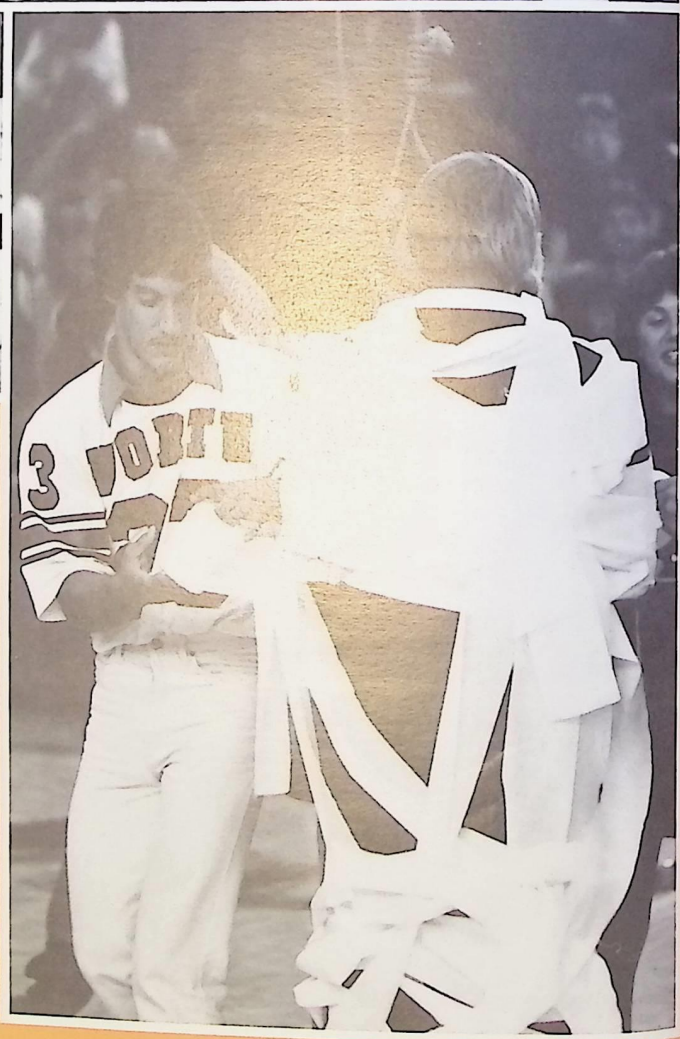
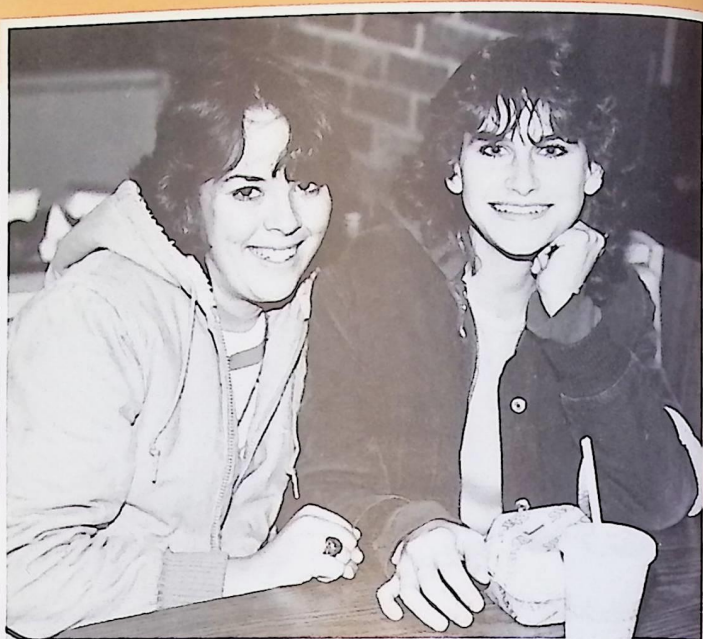


OBSERVATION: The teen is ruled by his wide range of emotions.

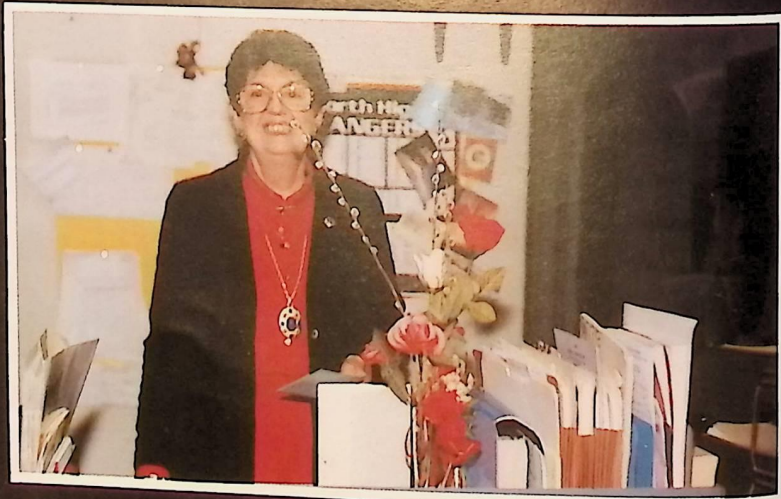
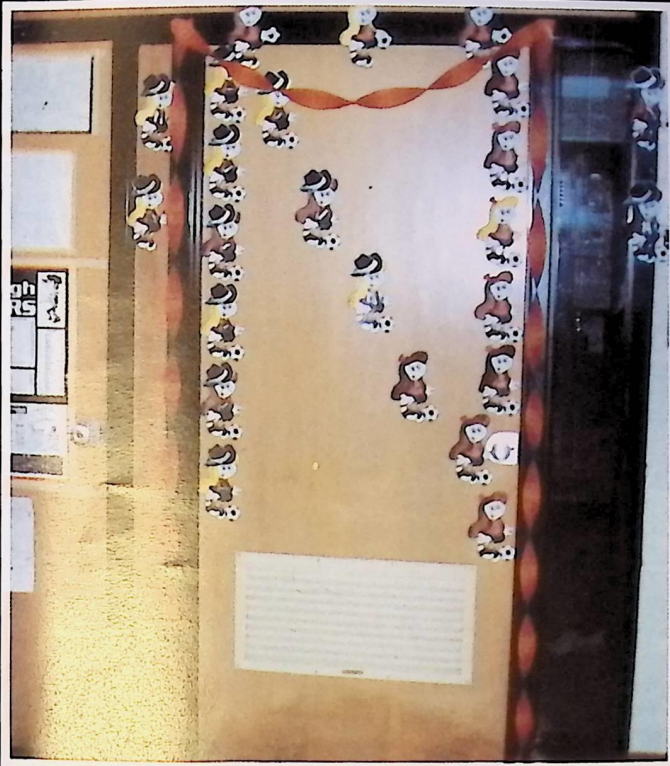
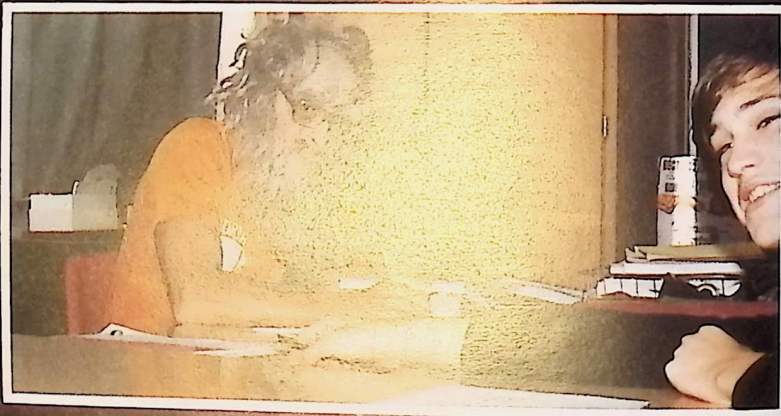
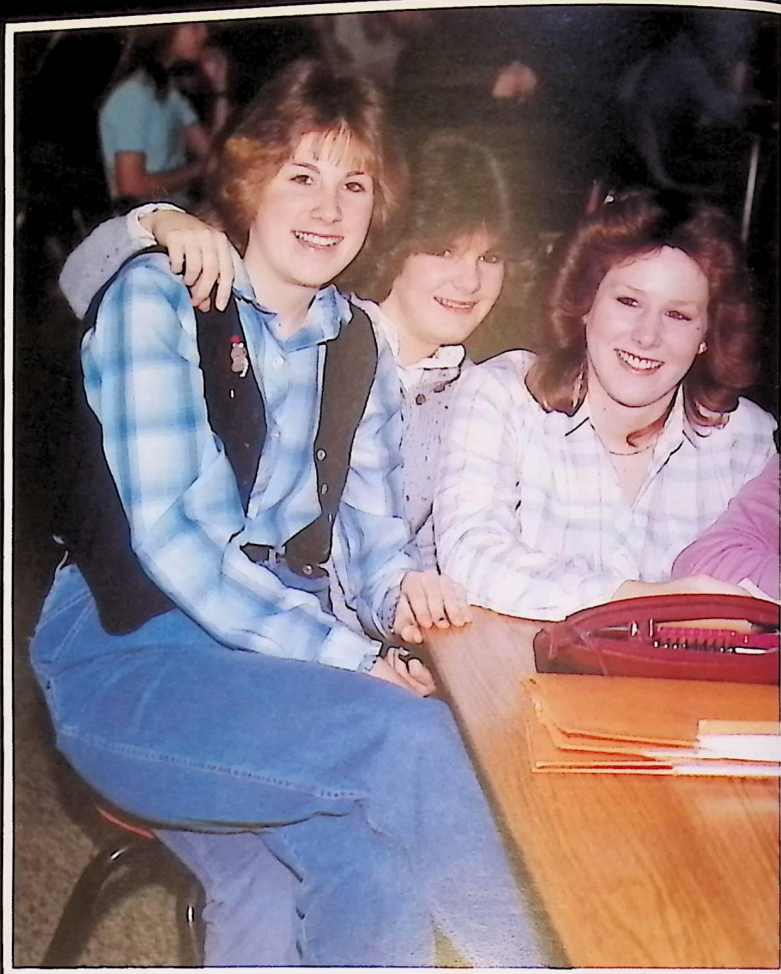
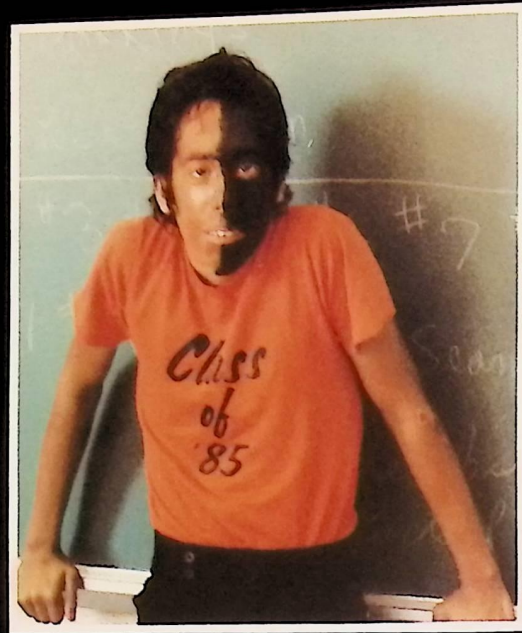


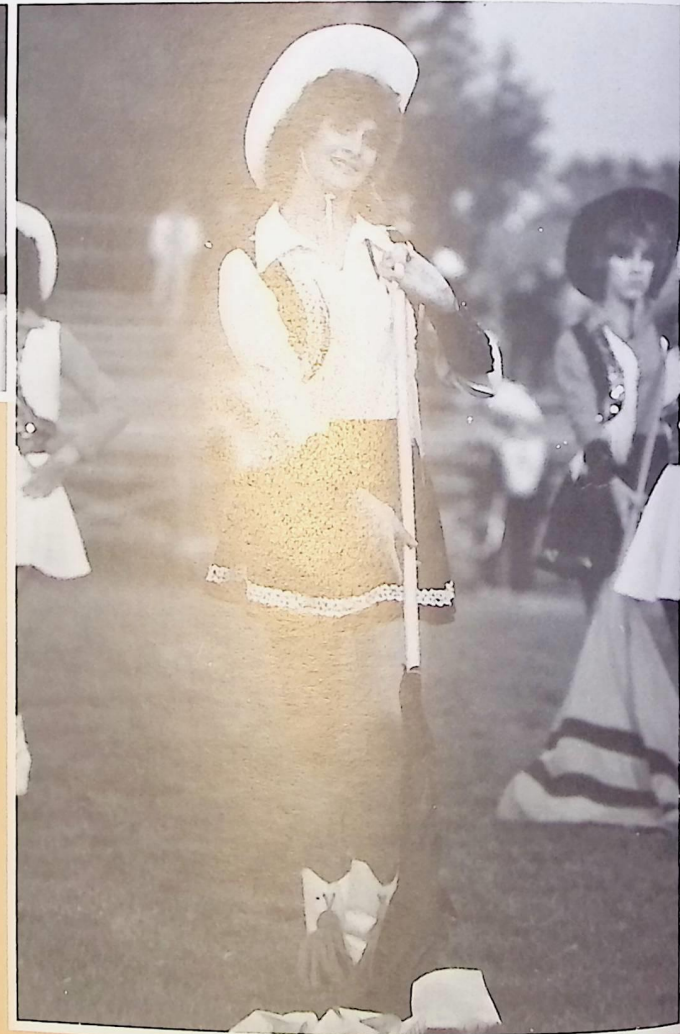




OBSERVATION: The teen cares deeply for "North".

OBSERVATION: The Teen is obsessed with having fun.

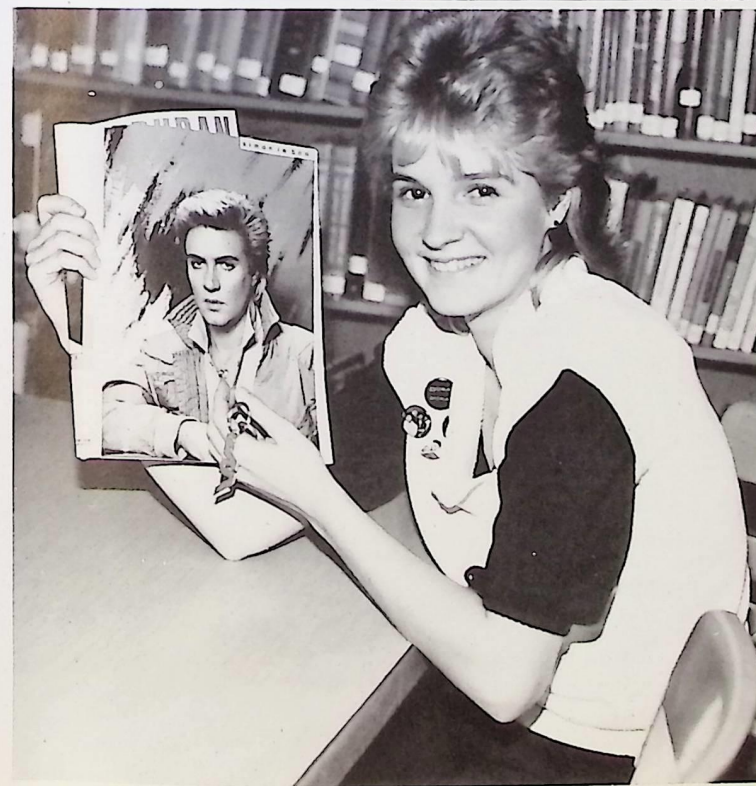
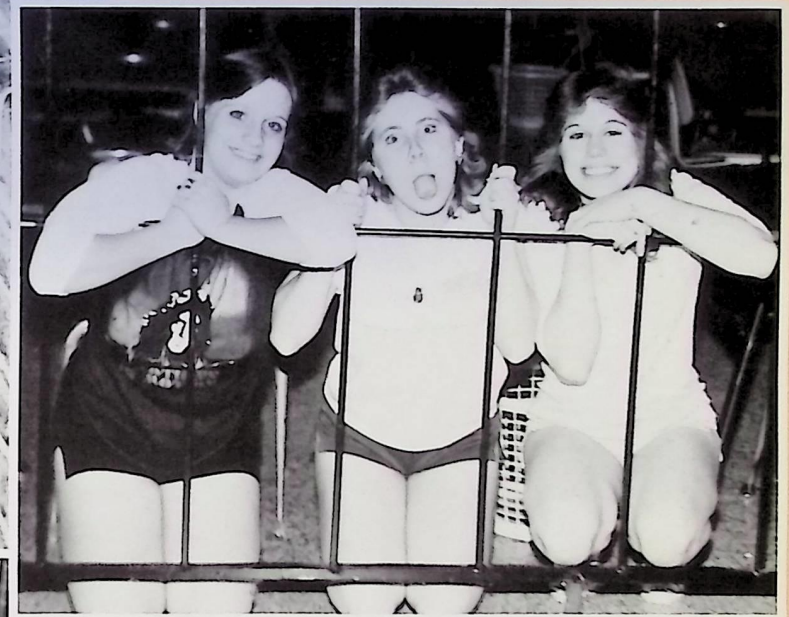

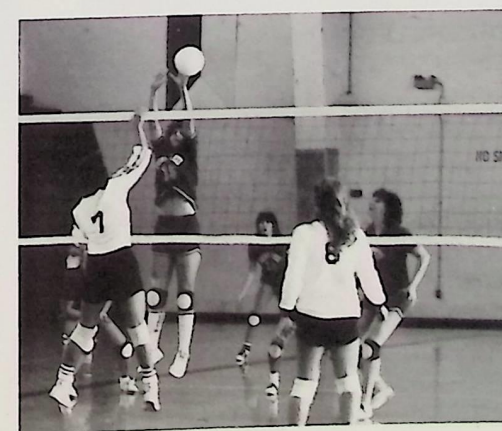
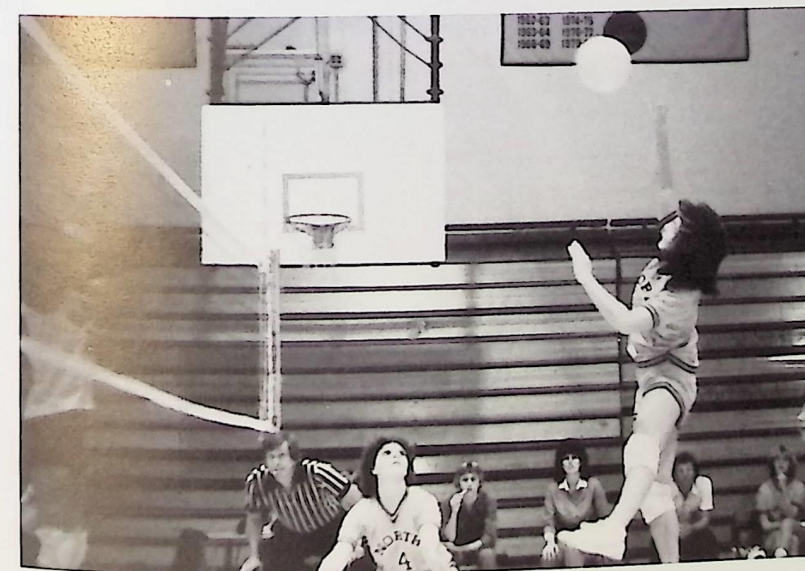
In the sectional tournament, North beat Geneva in the first round before losing to Solon -

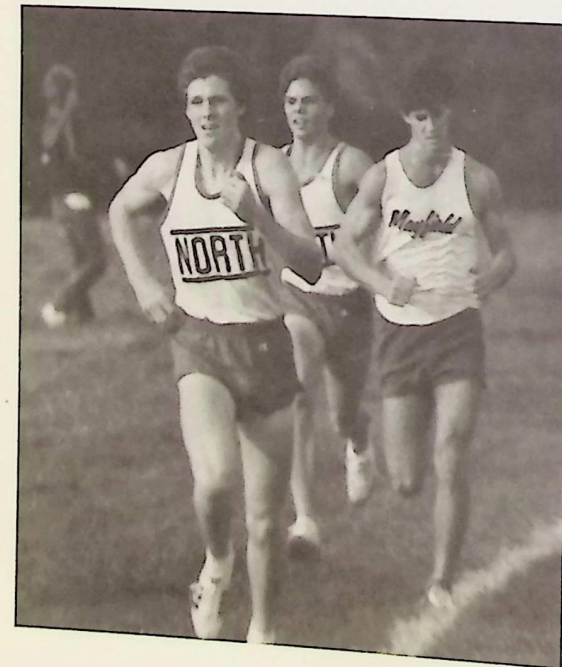




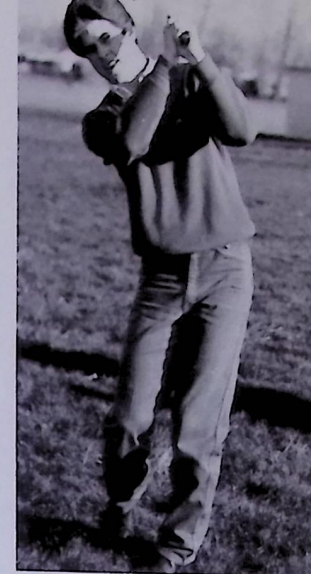
Runners Display Promise!

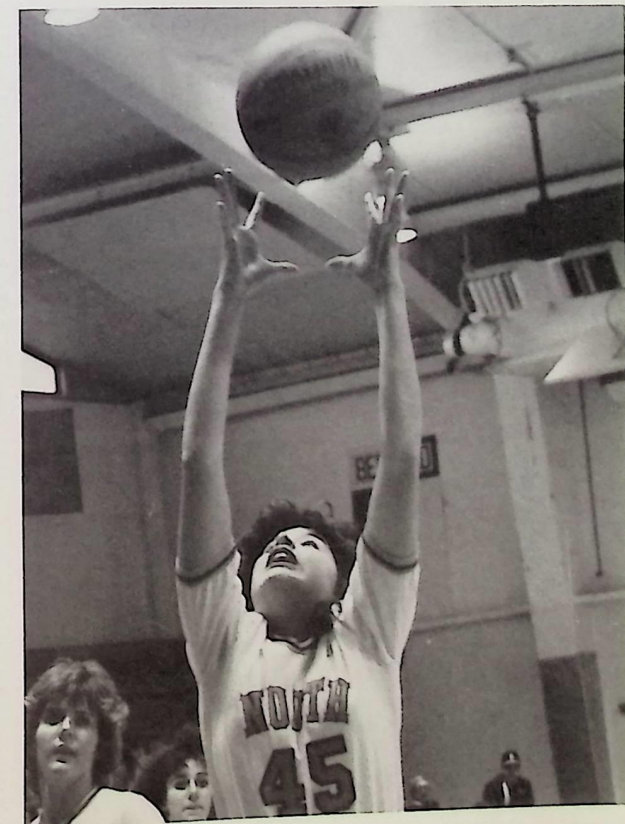
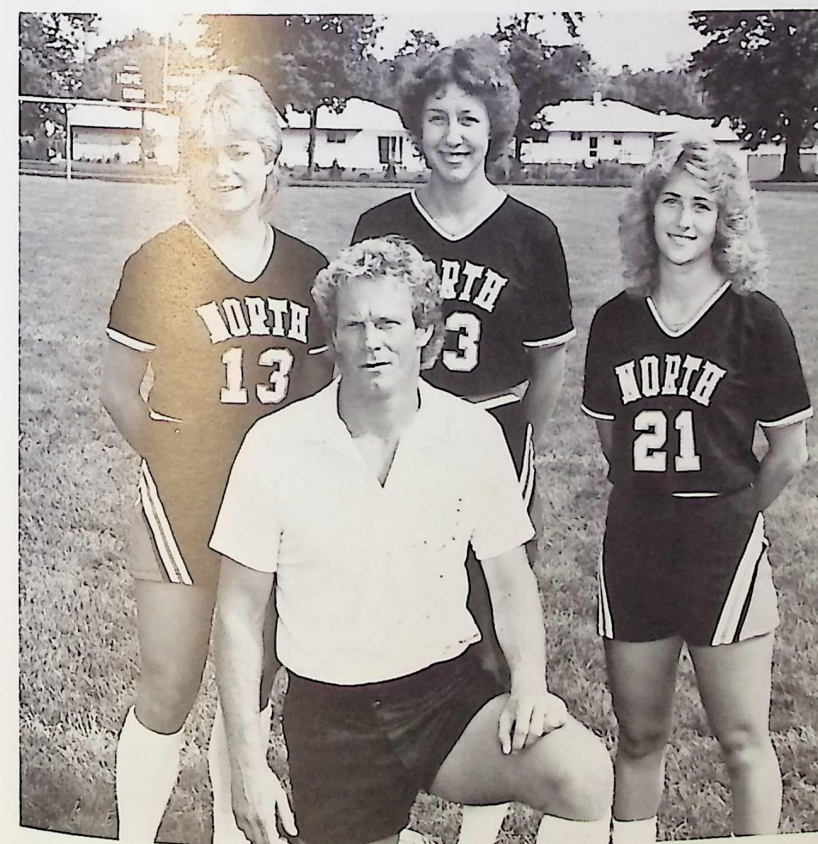
Observation: The Lady Cagers are "small but mighty."

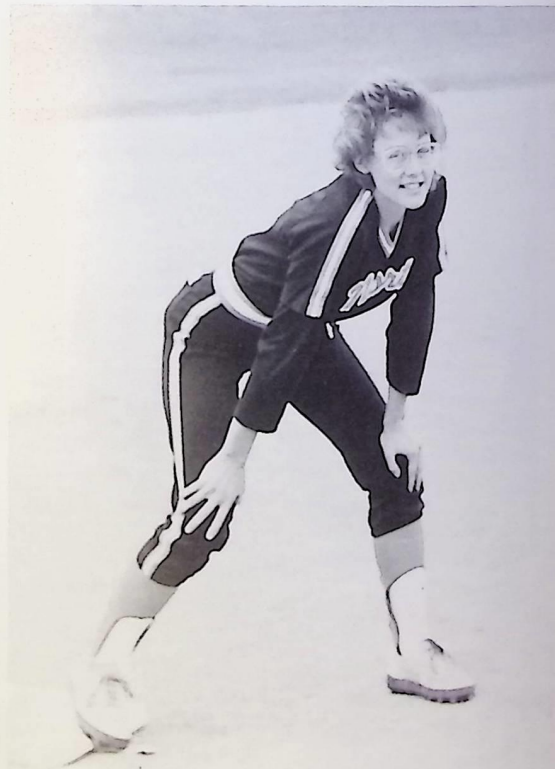


Team Displays Strong Defensive

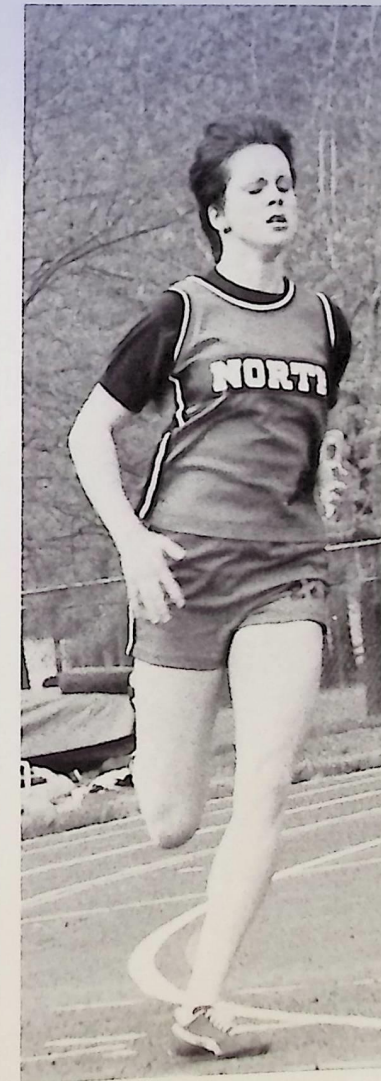
Observation: The team placed fourth at the GCC relays.

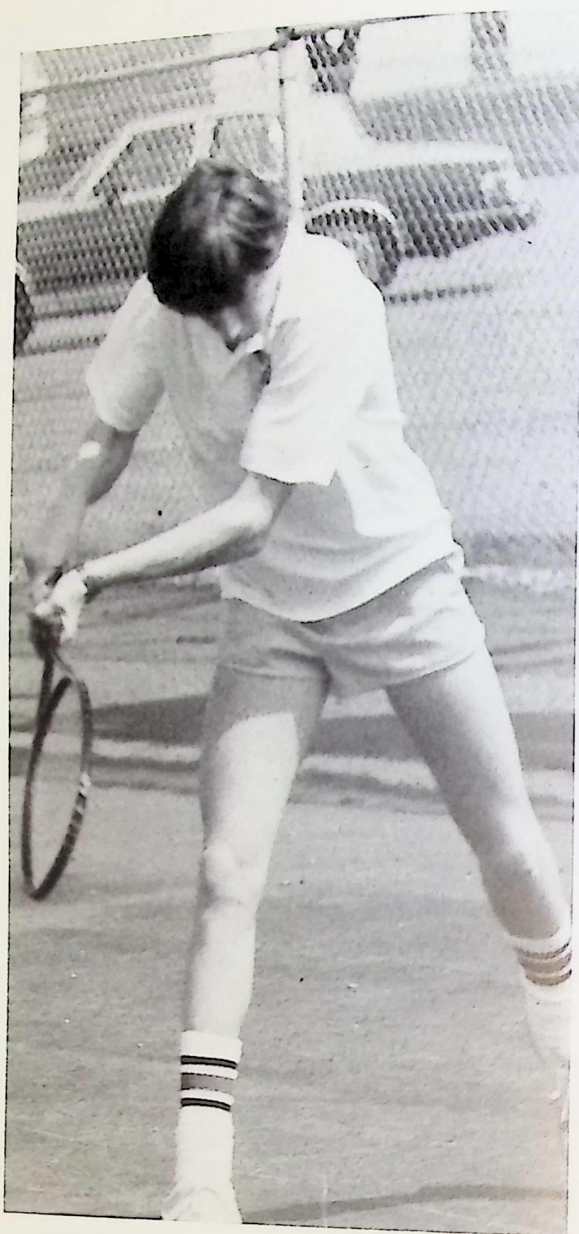

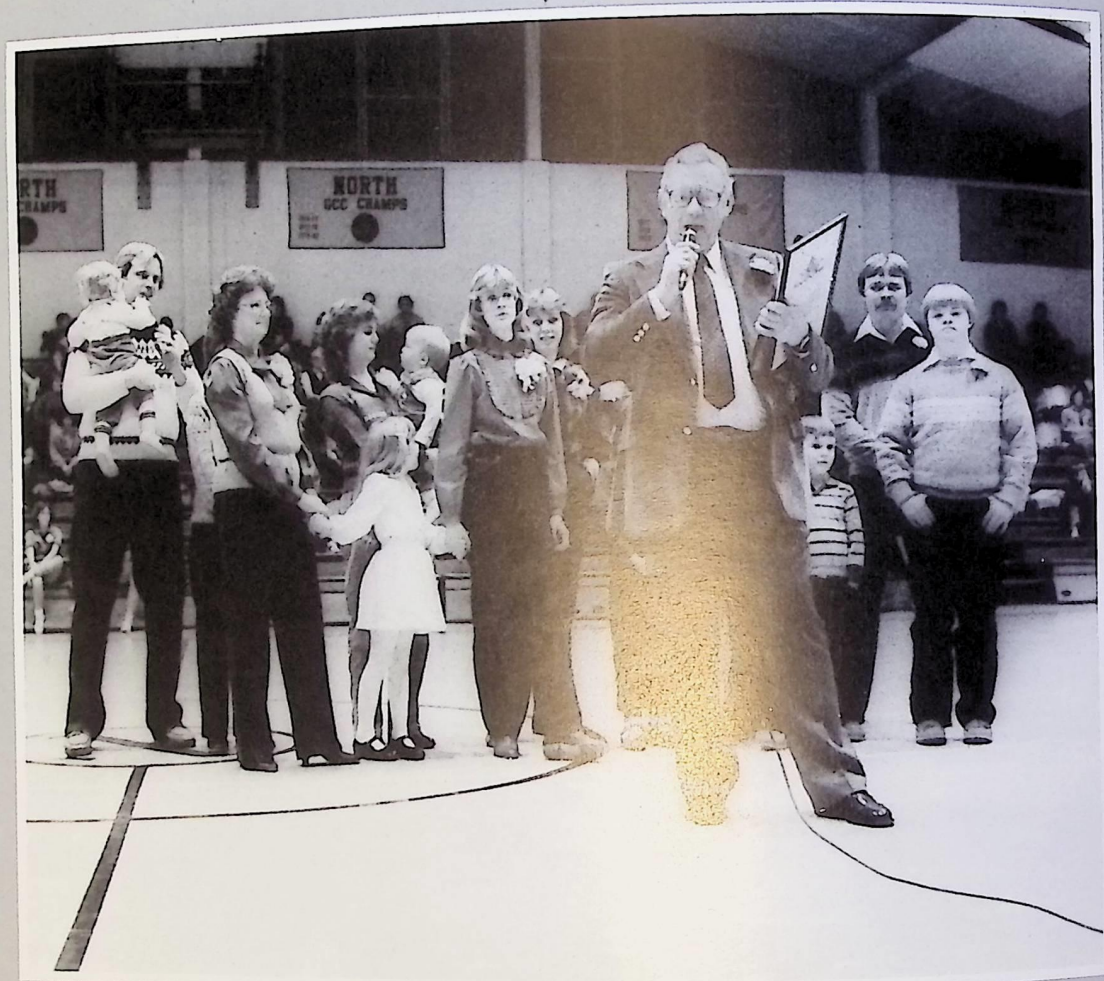

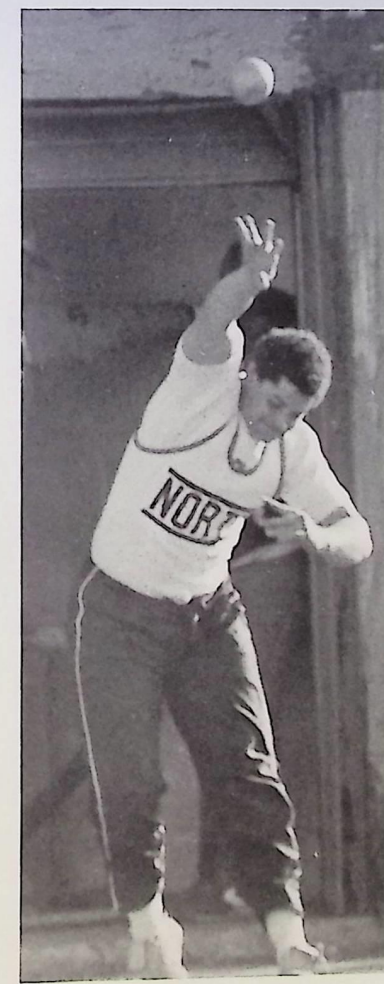
North Bids Farewell To Mr. Crowe.
