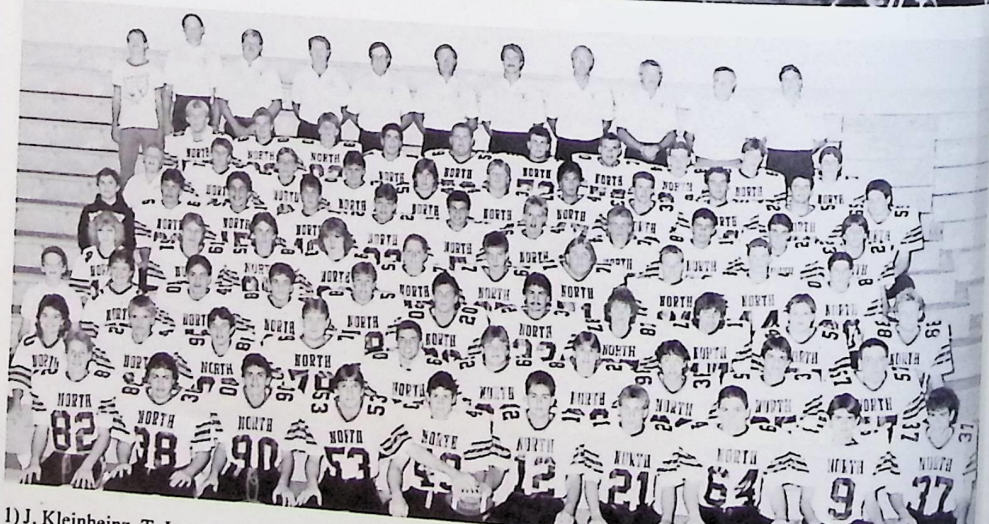
## FOOTBALL

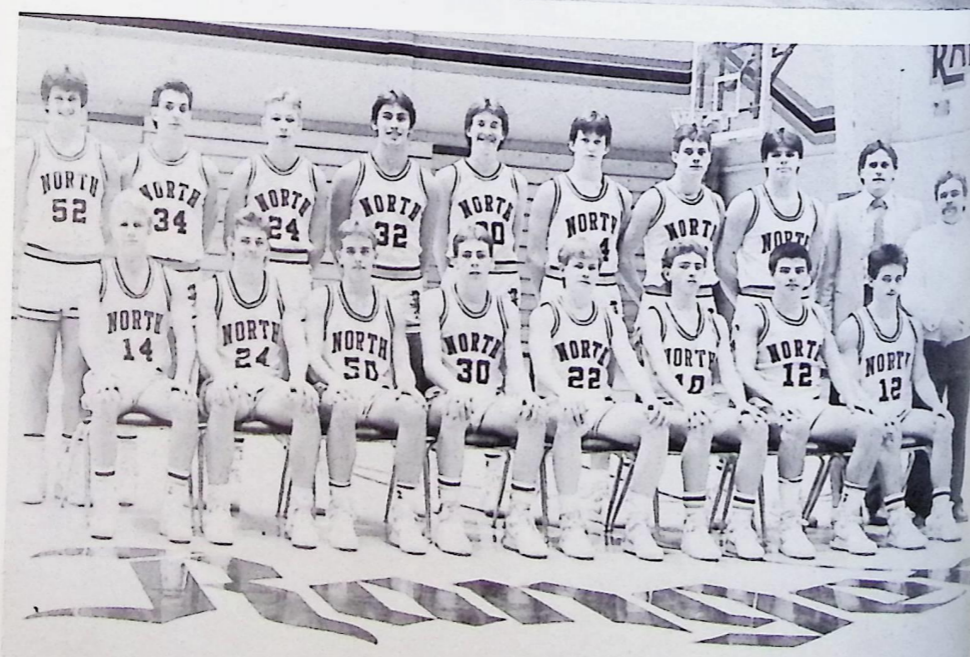
## Dunkers Have a "Hey-Ladi" of a Season

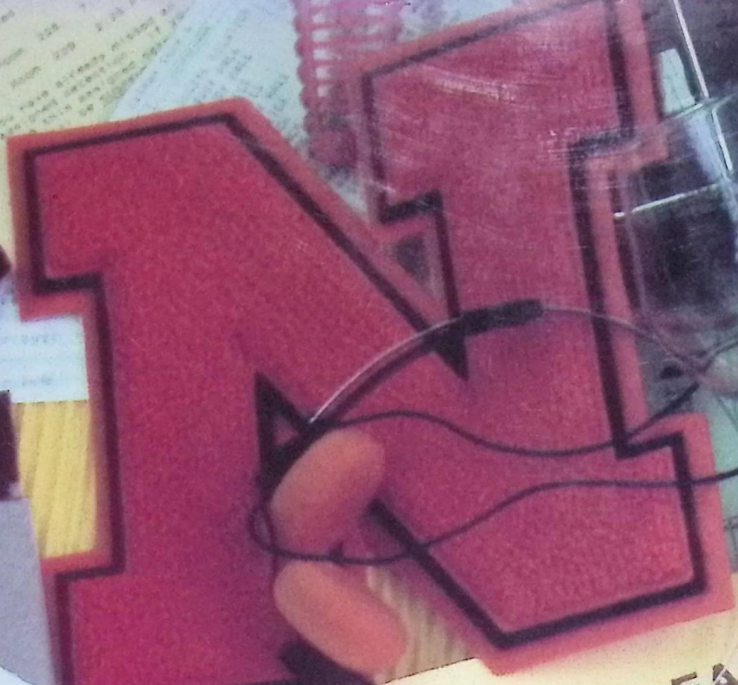
FOREIGN EXCHANGE

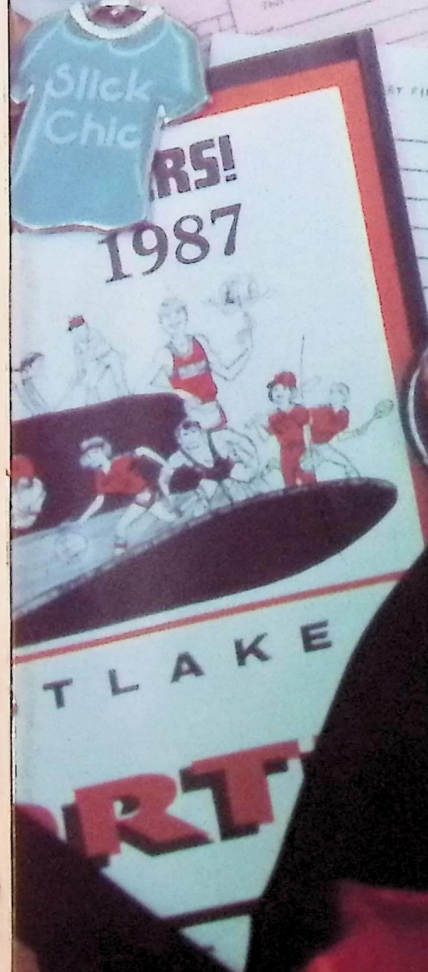
