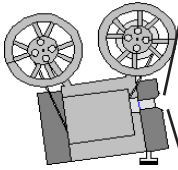

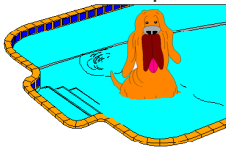


## **DOG DAYZ SWIM AT MANRY POOL**

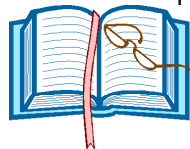

## **WILLOWICK DAY CAMP - June 4<sup>th</sup> to August 3<sup>rd</sup>**

Willowick Day Camp is a nine-week program and is available to children ages 5 to 12 years old. Your child must turn 5 years old by June 1<sup>st</sup> in order to participate. Camp fees include off-site field trips, a Camp/Swim I.D pass (good for the entire summer at both pools), a camp t-shirt and all crafts and supplies. Camp is held Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 4:30pm (No camp on Wednesday July 4<sup>th</sup>). Kids will need to bring a packed lunch daily to camp along with their swimsuit, towel, tennis shoes and socks. They can also bring a small amount of money for use at the concession stand.



Our camp is staffed with qualified teachers as well as creative college students who are striving to become professionals in a wide variety of fields. It is our goal to make summer camp an enjoyable experience where children can learn and play in a safe environment. The combination of different activities throughout the day along with a weekly field trip will keep the kids interested and eager to come to camp.
