1. Maximum number of college hours eligible for College Credit Plus participation.	30	
2. Number of Carnegie Units to be taken at the high school (for the entire school year.)		
3. Conversion of Carnegie Units to College Hours. (Line #2 multiplied by 3 = college hours) (1 Carnegie Unit equals 3 college semester hours)		
4. Remaining number of college hours eligible for College Credit Plus participation. (Line #1 minus line #3)		
5. College hours enrolled at the primary College/University.	Summer Credits
