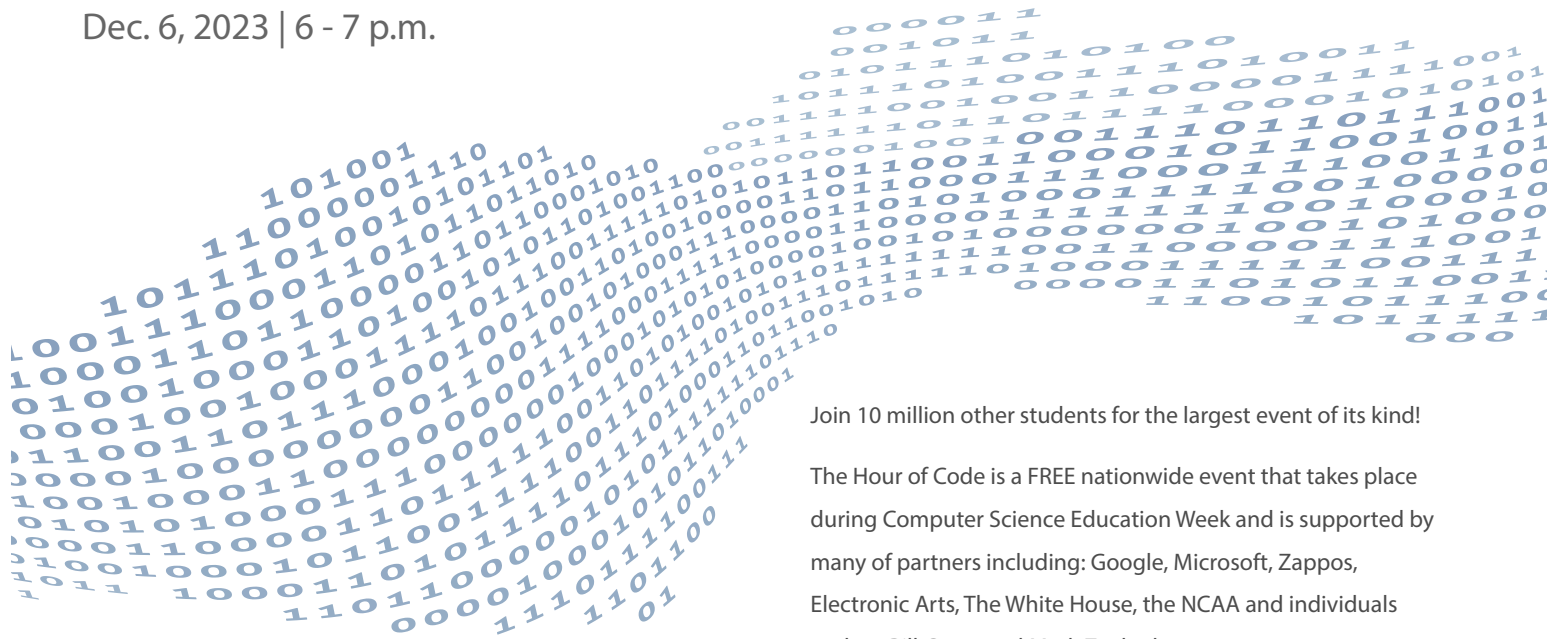


Hour of Code
