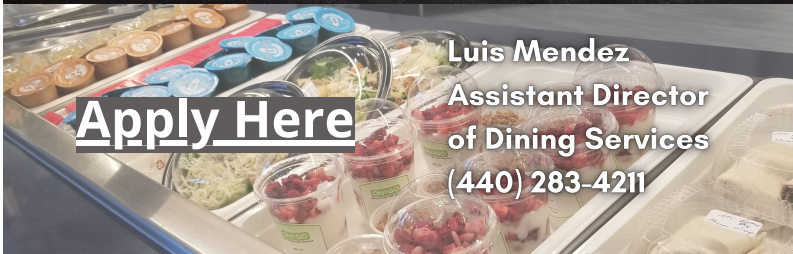


# Come work with Food Service
