


Welcome Back to Distance Learning

During the first week of distance learning, our students, staff and parents accomplished remarkable tasks.

- ⇒ All district teachers moved to online instruction



Election Day Has Been Changed

As of now, in-person voting has been cancelled. If you wish to vote on ISSUE 1 in the primary, you must vote absentee.

Election Facts:



Absentee Ballot applications can be submitted now and will be processed by the Board of Elections.



All voting must be done via Absentee Ballot.



All voting must be completed by April 28, 2020.



If you are mailing your ballot back to the Board of Elections, ballots must be postmarked by April 27, 2020.



Passage of Issue 1 will allow the district to reinstate several November cuts and reinstate extracurricular activities for students.



School Lunch - When and Where?

Beginning Tuesday, March 31st, families in need are able to pick up breakfast and lunch for their children. This is open to all students under the age of 18, regardless of their free and reduced meal status.

- Tuesday meals will include food for Tuesday lunch, Wednesday breakfast, Wednesday lunch and Thursday breakfast.
- Thursday meals will include food for Thursday lunch, Friday breakfast, Friday lunch, Monday breakfast, Monday lunch and Tuesday breakfast.
- Pickup will be each Tuesday and Thursday at North
 High School between the hours of 11:30 a.m. and
 1:30 p.m.
- The District Ohio Department of Education requires
 all meals must be taken off site to be consumed.



- Families will not be permitted to enter the building when they arrive.
- Meals will be ready outside of the main entrance to the building.
- When arriving to pick up meals, parents will be asked to sign the name of students receiving meals.
