Once the new programs are launched, **NCI** is also planning to add: Physical Therapist Assistant, State Tested Nurse Assistant (STNA), Bridge Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) to Registered Nurse (RN), and Community Health Worker. As a free service to the community, NCI will begin offering community education classes covering topics such as reading your medical bills and understanding your healthcare provider.

The district has acquired a new building on Euclid Avenue, which will be the home of a second **NCI** campus. During the 2016 - 2017 school year, **NCI**-Willoughby Campus will house programs in the trades, including but not limited to Welding, Auto Collision, Auto Services and Cosmetology.

With the addition of new programs and a new building on Euclid Avenue, **NCI** will strive to help students identify with a school, not just a program. The two campuses will house the high school career/technical programs and bring students a "college" feel, while attending programs on a postsecondary campus.
