#### 2014-15 NEW SECURITY MEASURES

The Willoughby-Eastlake City School system has implemented new security measures throughout the district for the 2014-15 school year. The security measures are now in place at Willowick Middle School. All visitors will be expected to follow the guidelines listed below.

- A waiting area has been created to secure admittance to Willowick Middle School. Upon arrival, all visitors will be
  required to sign in and present a photo ID (driver's license) to the monitors, which will be held by the monitor until
  the visitor leaves the school.
- All items being dropped off will be given to the monitor in the waiting area; parents will not need to sign in.
- If picking up a student from the clinic or for early release, a driver's license or state issued ID must be presented to the door monitor. A pass will be issued and the parent will go to the main office or the clinic. The same procedure will be followed for any visitors attending meetings in the school.




