
## Quiz Bowl

# History of North

The legacy of Eastlake North High is detailed and interesting, but unknown to most. After it became clear that Willoughby Union High just couldn't meet the demands that the Baby Boom had presented, the decision was made to construct two new schools. Eastlake North and Willoughby South, which was finished in 1958 and 1959, respectively. Both schools were state of the art for the time and were quickly poulated with the children of the G.I. Generation. The North building saw it all: The Red Scare, The war in Vietnam, the hippie movement, civil rights, and the post 9/11 era. Some current students of North are third-generation Rangers, whose grandparents were some of the first students to walk these halls. Before the active shooter drills of today came the "duck and cover" drills of the 1950s and early sixties. However, even with all these differences, an old boomer, a millennial, and a modern North student are all one in the same: Rangers.



Given that the old building is being demolished this summer, North held an event in order to allow former students to walk the halls one last time and reminisce about the good ol' times.




North Highschool, circa 1958. This was the first year that the school was opened.






