At the Y, we value the unique personalities and potential of every child and teen. Summer Camp creates an environment where kids can be themselves, discover exciting new things, cultivate friendships and make memories to last a lifetime.

CAMP LEADERSHIP

Pattie Ritt, Child Care Director, heads West End Y Day Camp.

Our leadership staff have many years of experience directing YMCA camping programs to literally thousands of children. Counselors are chosen for their maturity, desire and ability to be good role models for campers, educational background and ability to interact with and create a fun environment for kids. Our camp staff are background checked and trained in CPR, First-Aid, behavior and conflict management, risk management, leadership, and thorough emergency procedures.

A ONE-OF-A-KIND OUTDOOR Y

In addition to the great facilities at the East End Y, day campers can also look forward to visiting the Outdoor Y in Perry. The Outdoor Y has a large Family Aquatic Center with an Olympic size pool, spiral water slide, and a drop slide along with two aqua climbing walls. The Family Aquatic Center also has an interactive spray-n-play area including a double dump bucket that gradually fills itself and then spills, a rain castle, a rain hoop that produces a rainbow-like shimmer of water, circle jets, and rain tunnel with jets of water coming from the concrete pad at such an angle that they "sculpt" a tunnel.

On the rest of its 177 acres, the Outdoor Y has an in-line skating rink, basketball court, tennis court, volleyball court, playground, athletic fields, and scenic wooded trails leading down to the Grand River.

PREPARE FOR FUN

Our Day Camp offers a wide array of activities including field trips, swimming, arts and crafts, games, sports, nature activities, special events, songs, skits and more. Even rainy days are fun! Many of our activities include getting wet, dirty and very messy! Please make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothes to take part in such activities.

CAMPER AGE GROUPS

Pioneers

Entering Grades 1 & 2

Introduces the fun of camping — crafts, games, sing-a-longs, and more—all in a kid-paced environment, with swimming, field trips, and special on-site programs.

Adventurers

Entering Grades 3 & 4

Experience Y camping at a new level with activities such as art, field trips, weekly themes, and overnights. Campers build relationships that last a lifetime while developing important life skills through Y character values.

Challengers

Entering Grades 5 & 6

In addition to theme activities, older campers have a special focus on personal challenges and group skills.

Explorers

Entering Grades 7 & 8

Teens concentrate on leadership development, including mentoring younger campers and special activities.

CAMPOUTS & OVERNIGHTS

Camp fires, night hikes, evening swims, late-night snacks, and sleeping out under the stars are just a few of the activities that happen during camp outs at the Outdoor Y. Campers should pack what they need for the night as well as their gear (lunch, swimsuit, towel, etc.) for camp the next day.

The fee is \$30 for Y Members and \$45 for Program Members. Overnights are staffed by Day Camp counselors.

SHIRTS

For identification purposes, each camper must purchase and wear a YMCA camp t-shirt for Tuesday trips. T-shirts are free for Y Members and \$10 for Program Members. Shirts will be given to campers on the first day they attend camp or at the time of registration. Any lost shirts or arrival on trip day without shirts will result in a \$10 charge for a new shirt.

REGISTRATION

PROGRAM FEE ASSISTANCE Deadline May 1, 2022

We believe that every child should have the opportunity to attend camp, but understand sometimes families need help with the cost. Thanks to generous donations we can help Y members. Applications available online and at the Y.

2022 FEES

A \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is required at the time of registration per child per week. The balance of fees is due on the Friday before each week of camp.

Y Members: \$120/week Program Members: \$160/week
Additional child \$110/week (Members ONLY)

There is a \$10 late fee for any payment made after the due date. Please assist us by submitting payments on time.

CAMPDOC

In continuous efforts to provide the best possible care to our campers, Lake County West End Day Camp is partnering with CampDoc.com. CampDoc.com is an electronic health record system for camps and will help us consolidate and integrate camper health information into a centralized and secure location. Their system will give our camp director instant access to camper health information, have quick digital access and assist in providing quality care for your camper.

The security, confidentiality and privacy of your camper's personal health information will always be protected. Only designated camp staff will have access to this information.

After you register for camp, watch your email for a welcome letter from CampDoc that will have a link for you to set up your account and begin to file your forms electronically! No more paper!! All forms must be on file PRIOR to your child's first day of camp.
